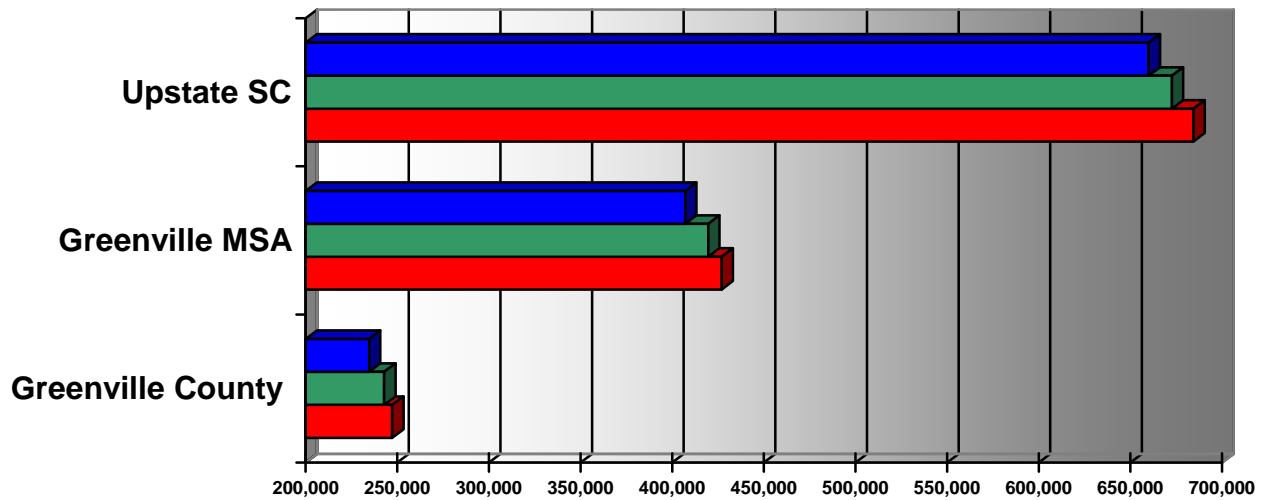

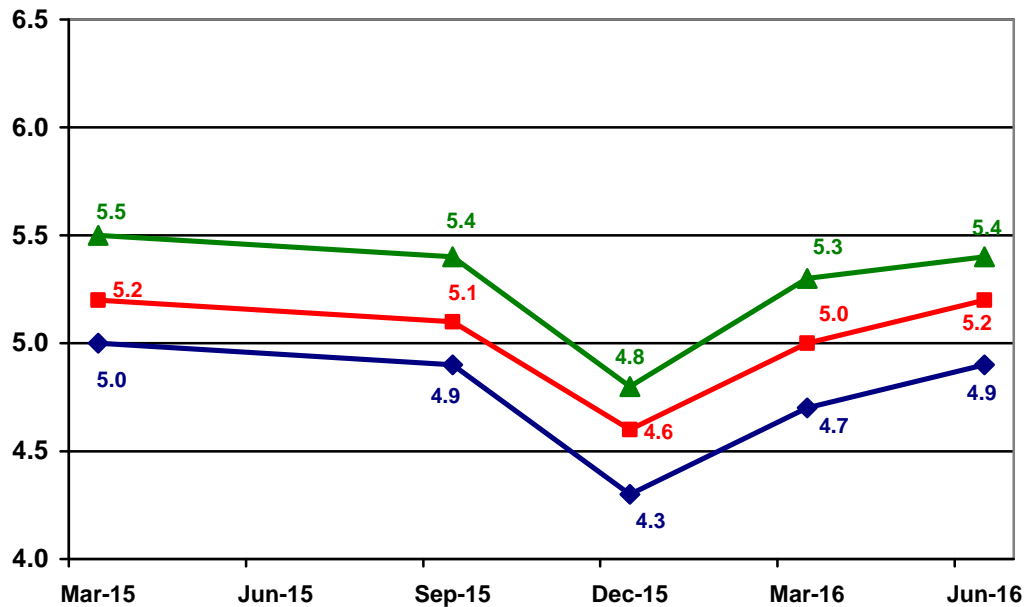

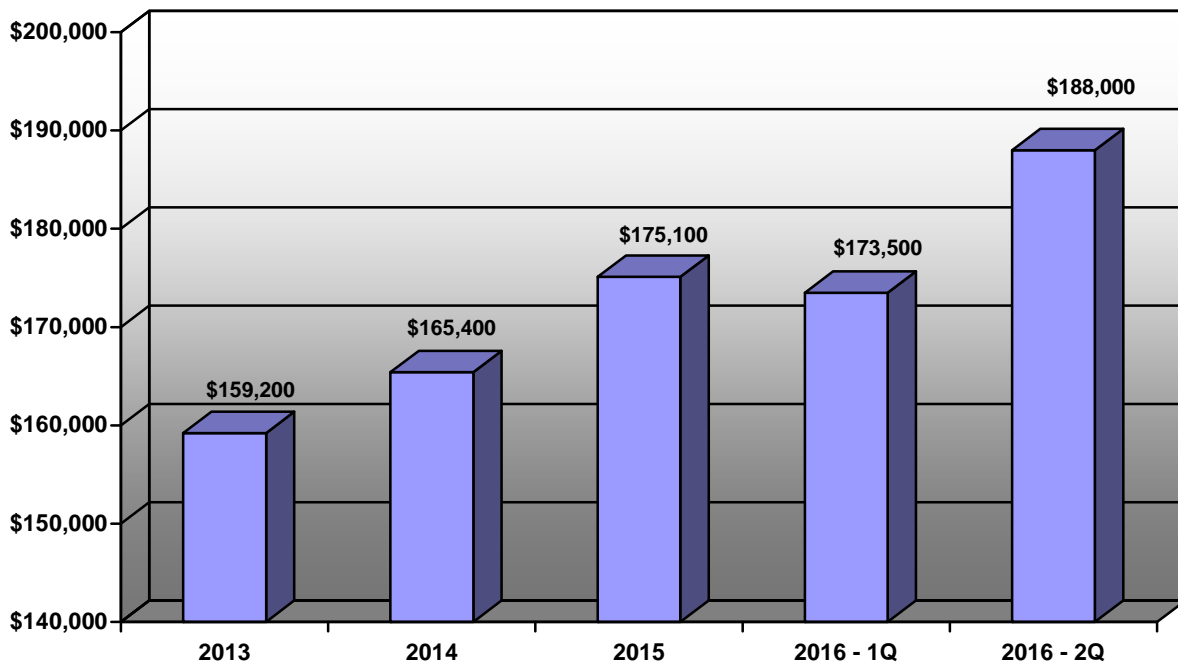

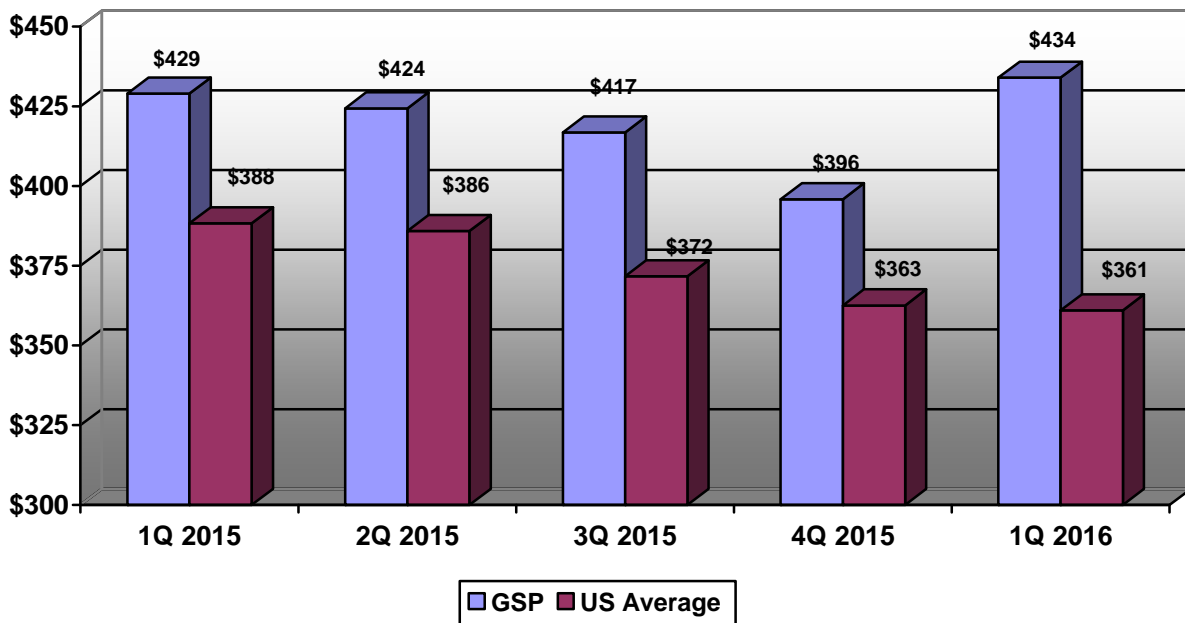
**Median Sales Price of Existing Single Family Homes

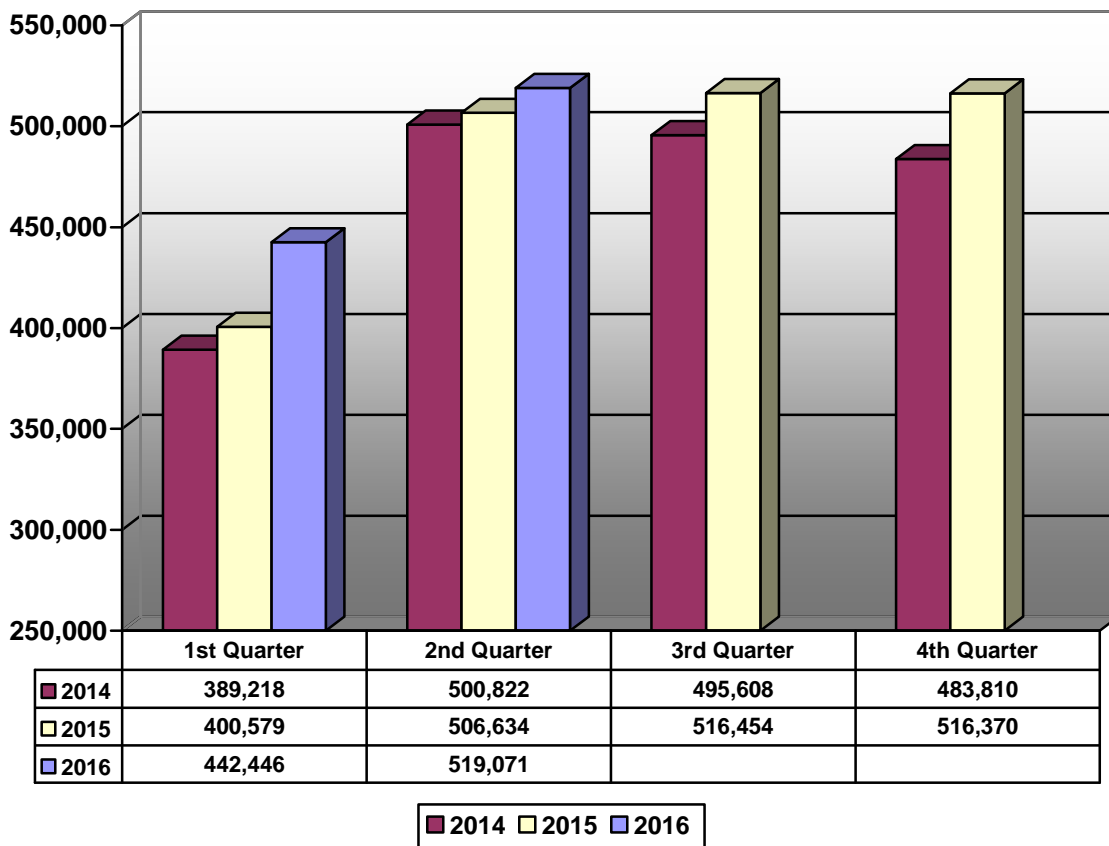

2014 – May 2016**

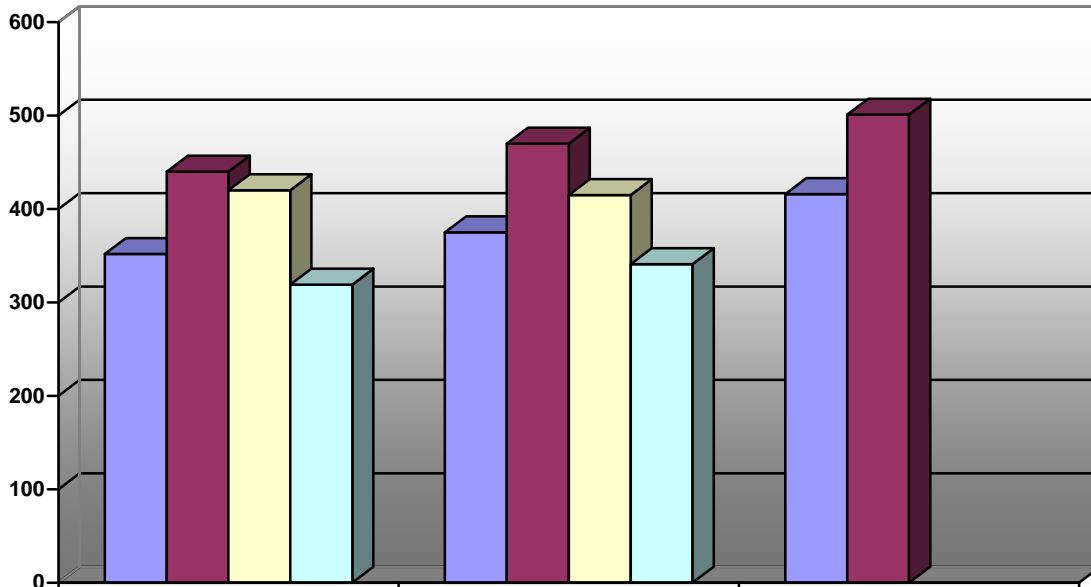

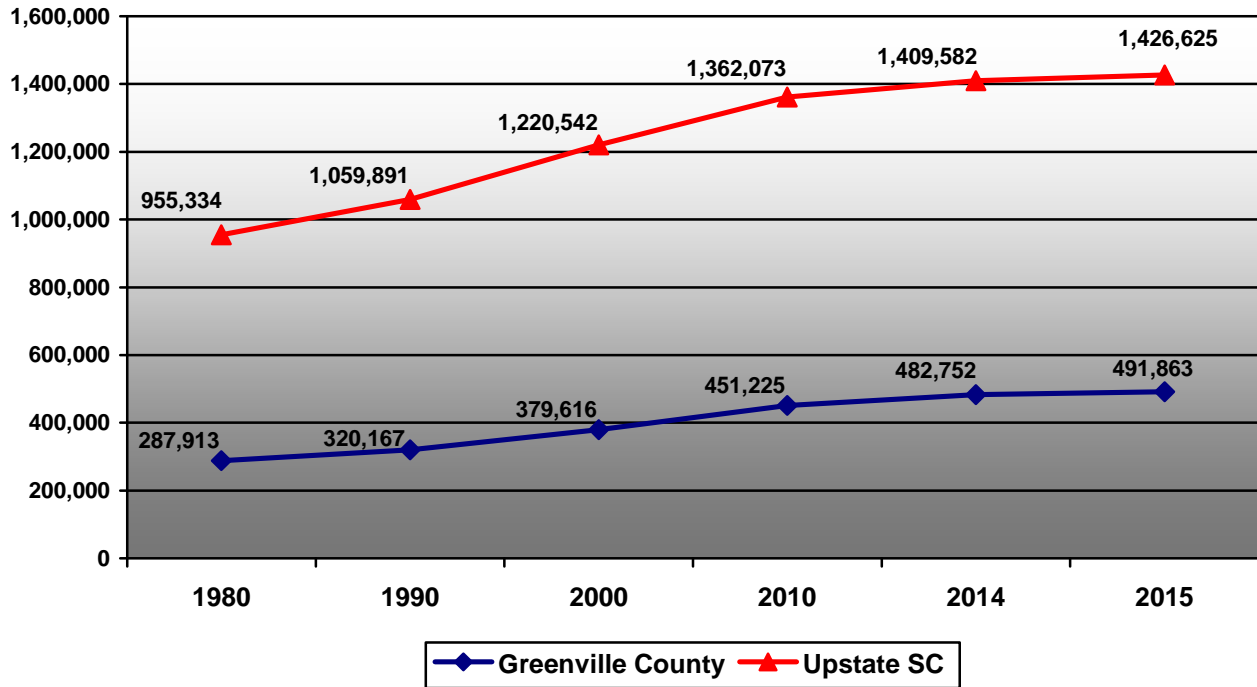
