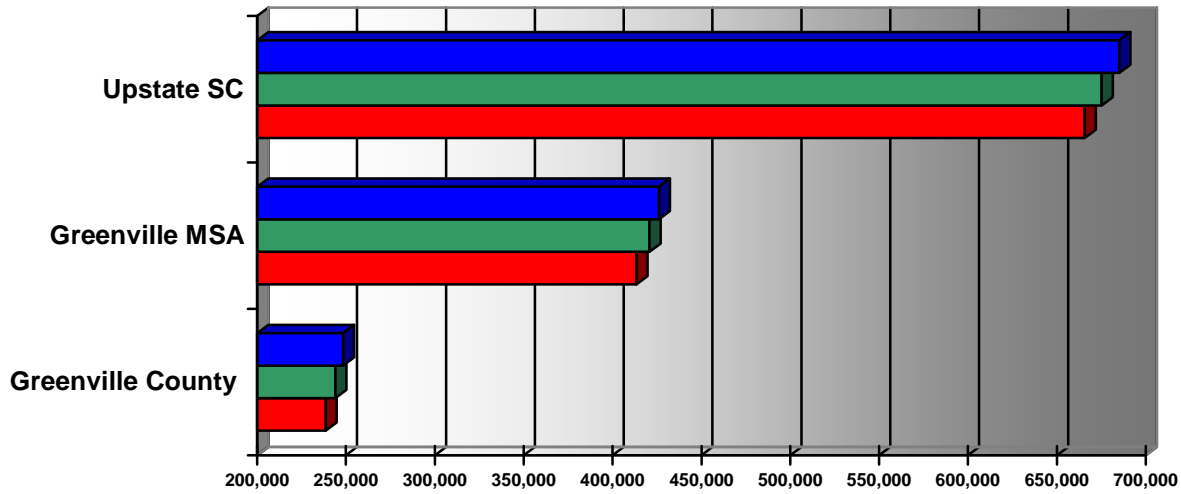

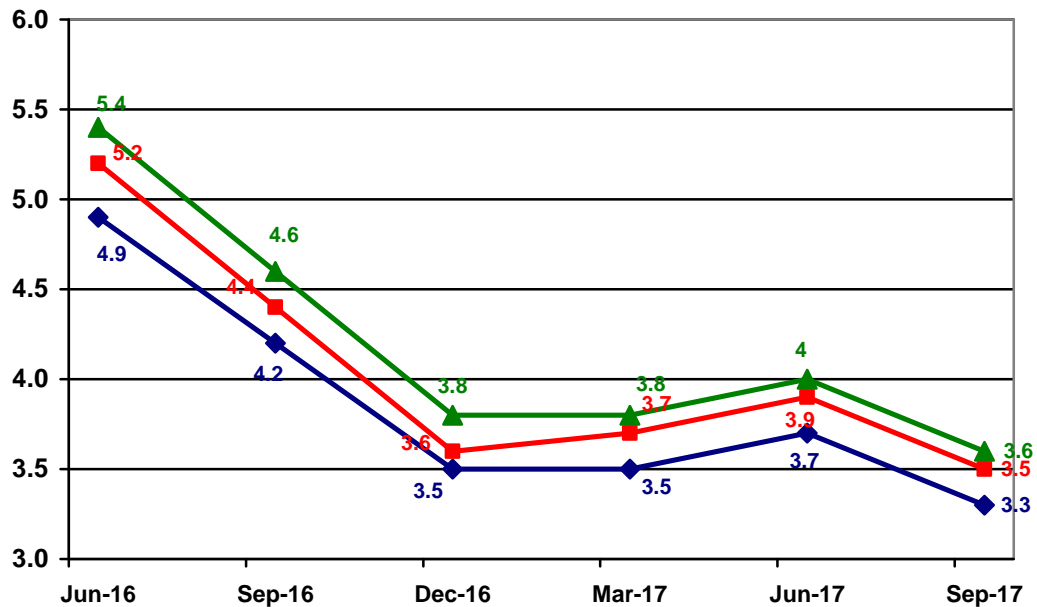

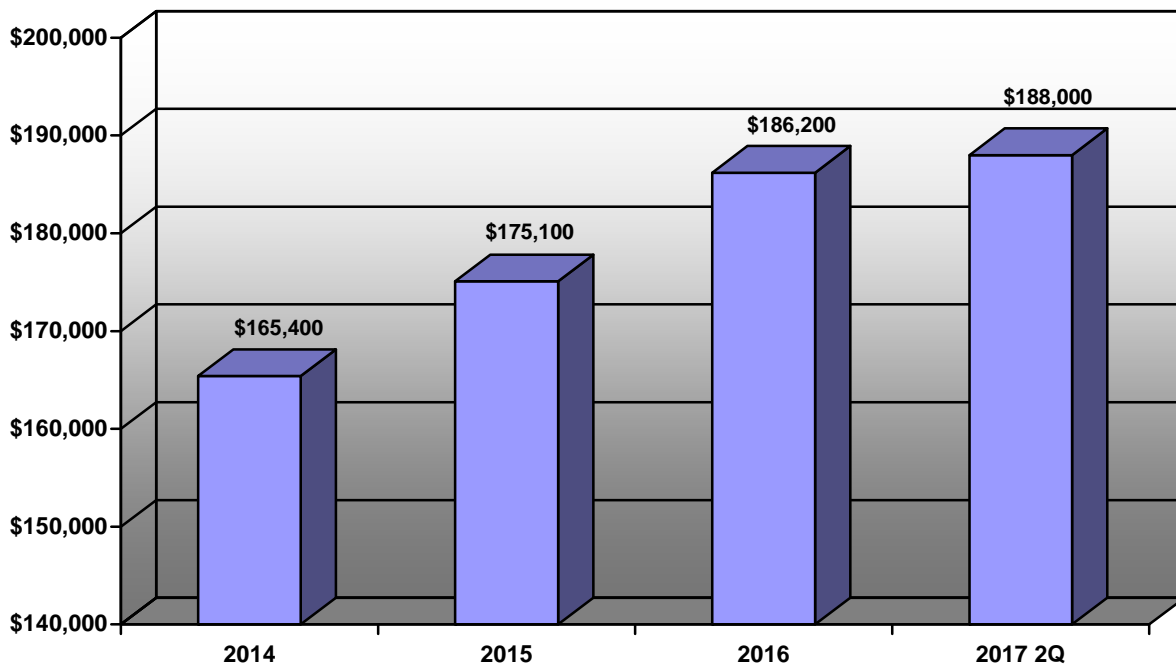

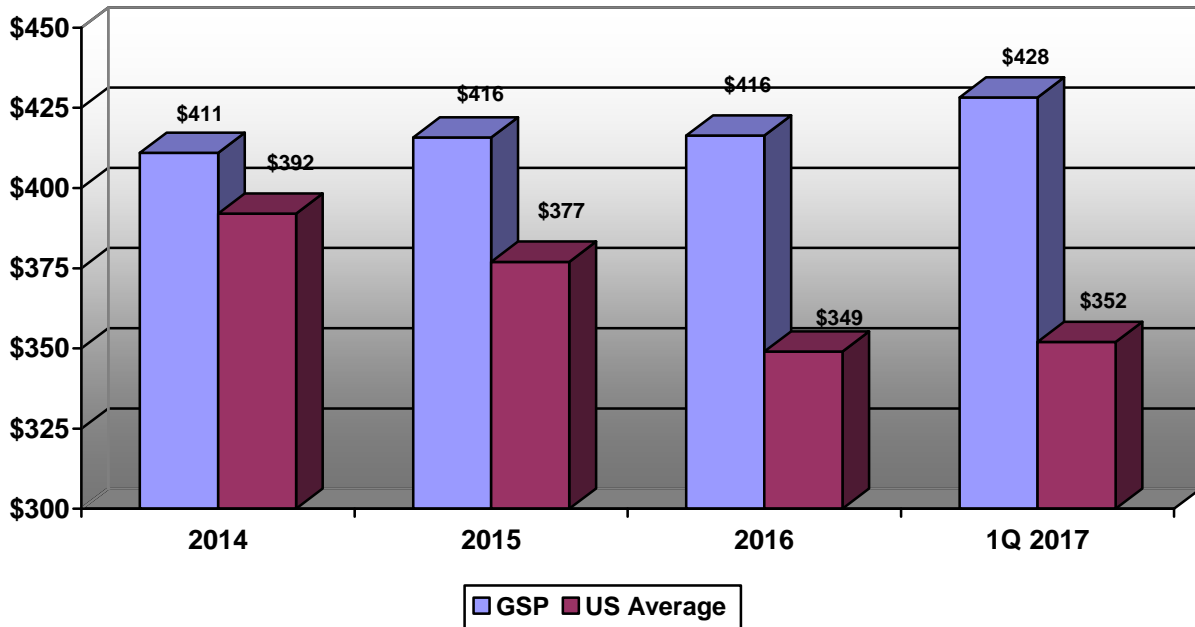
Median Sales Price of Existing Single Family Homes Greenville Metro Area, 2014 – 2017 2nd Quarter (p)

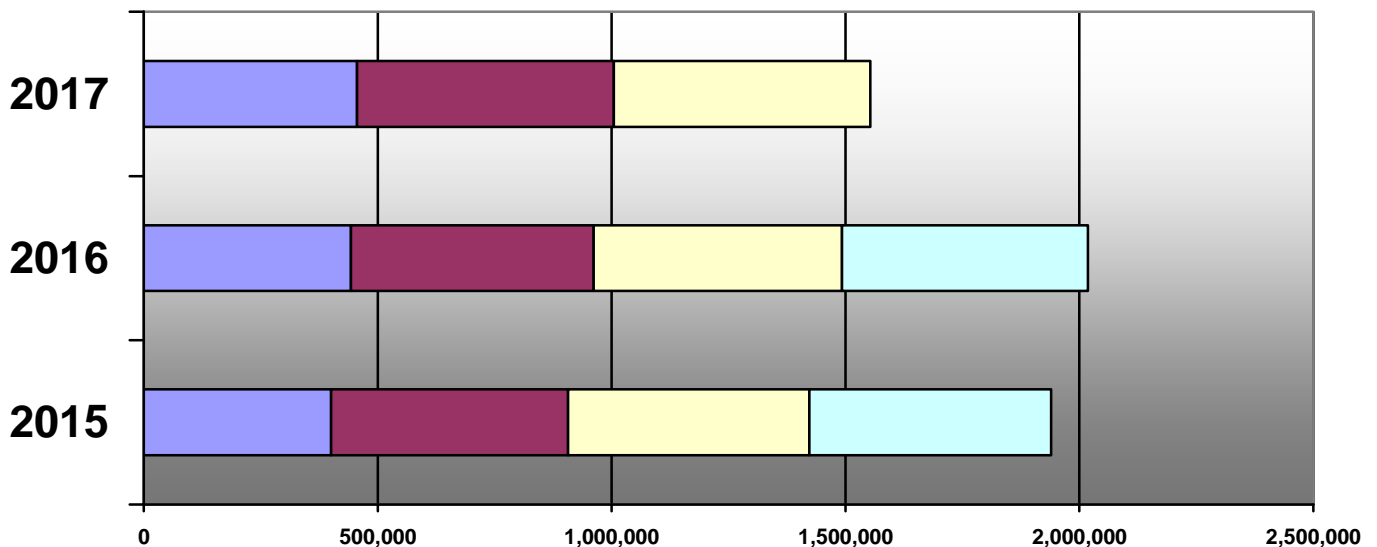

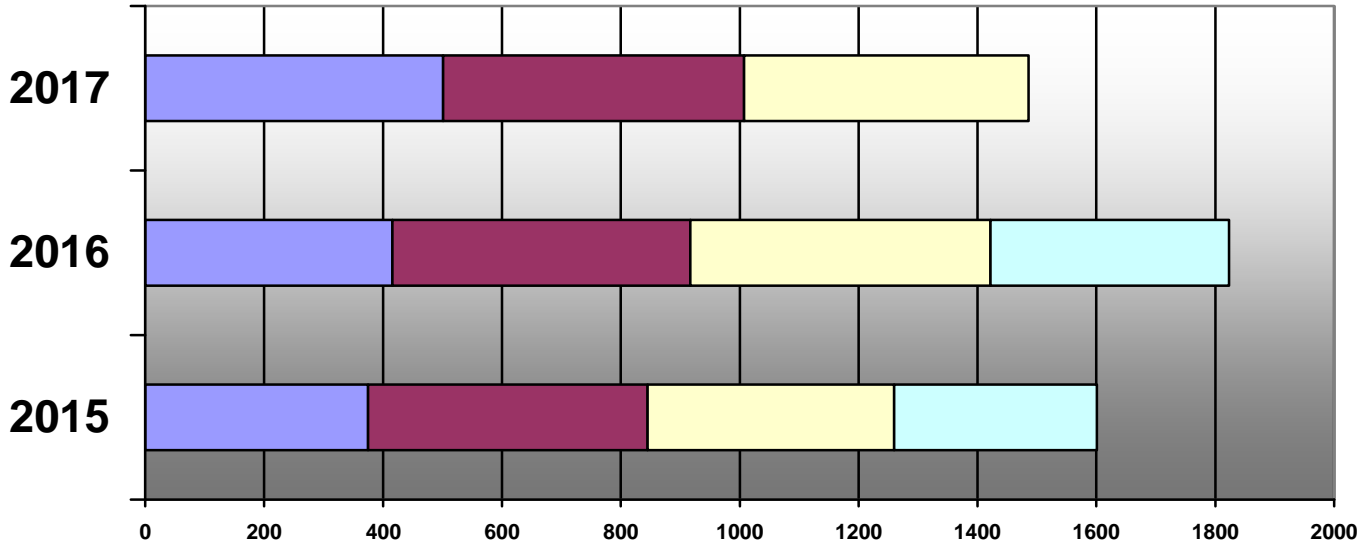

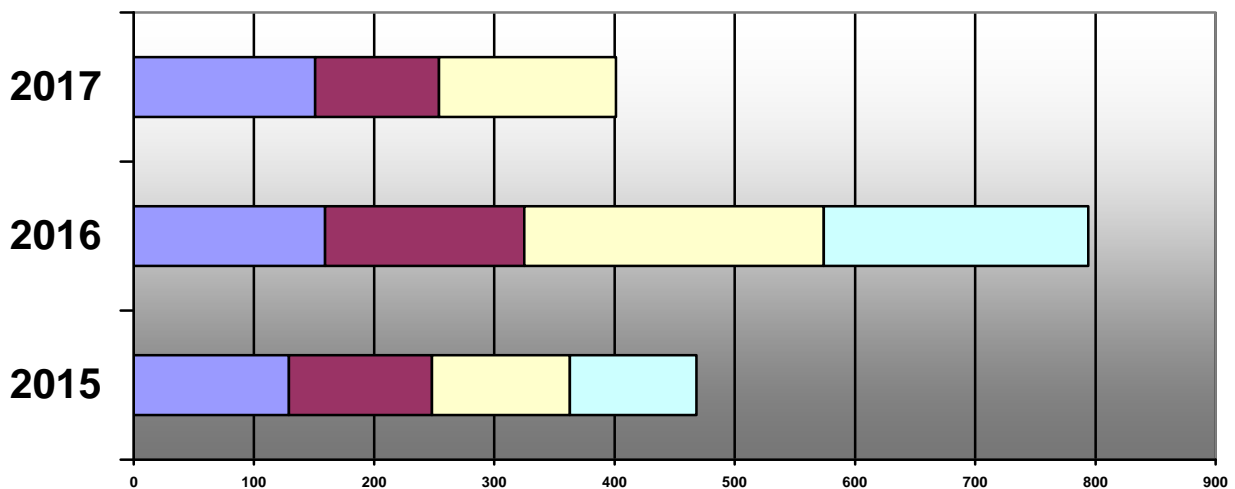

Commercial Building Permit Activity New Construction Permits Issued – Greenville County (unincorporated area)

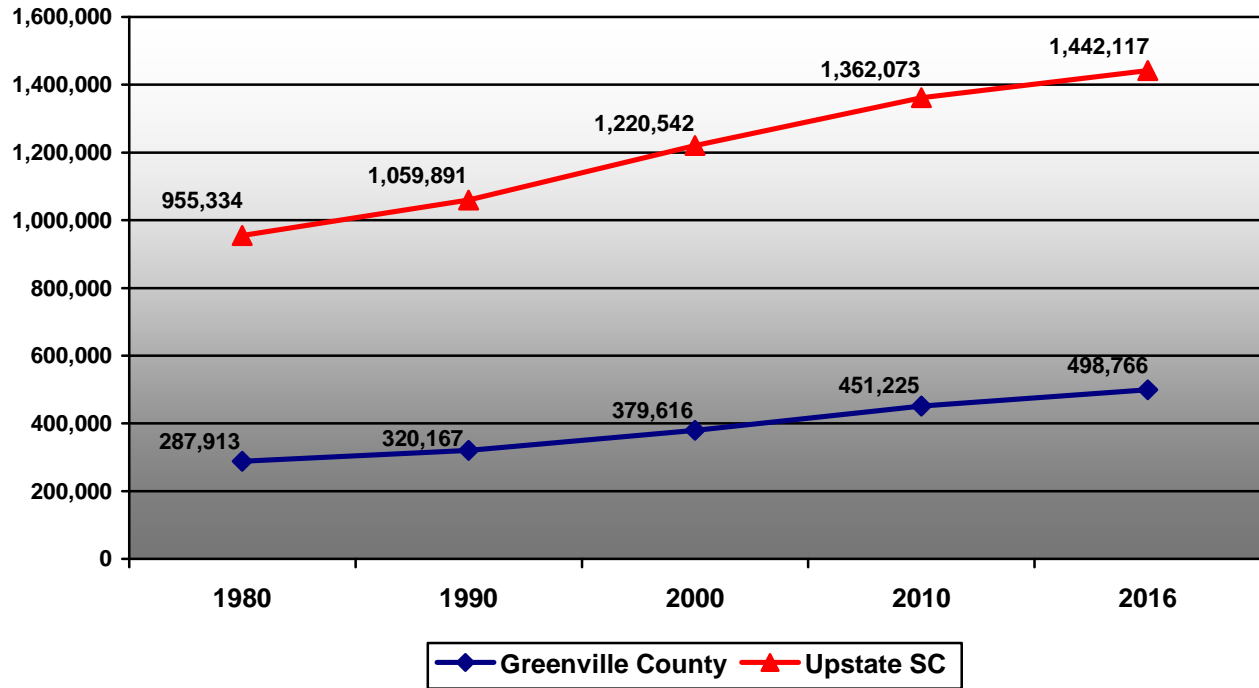
