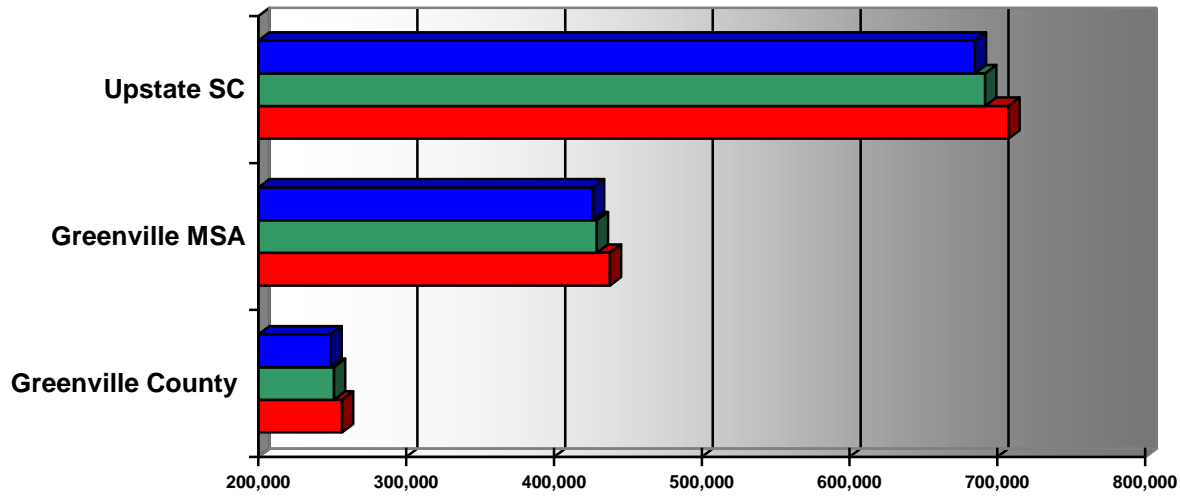

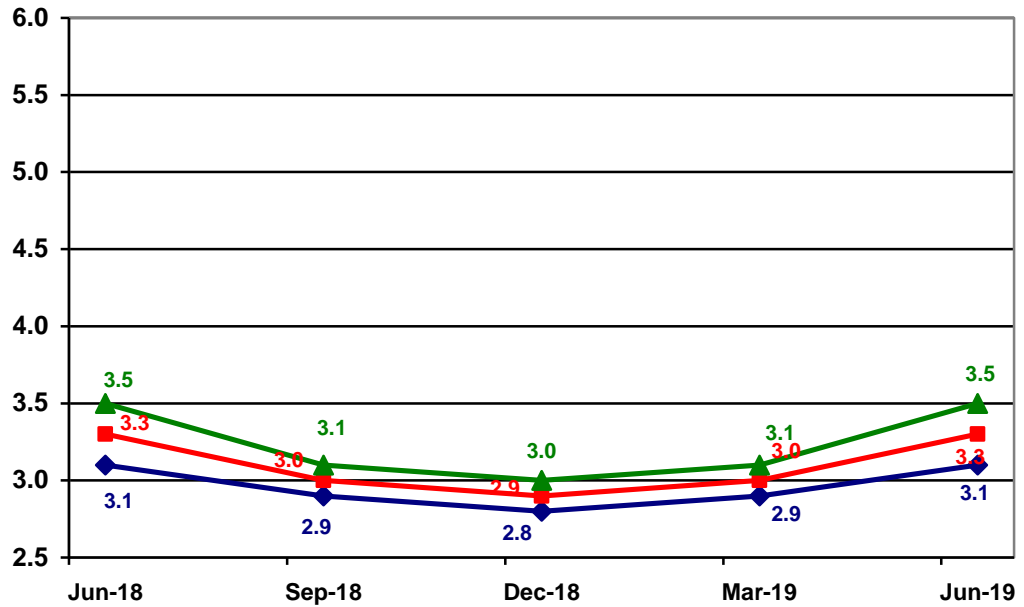

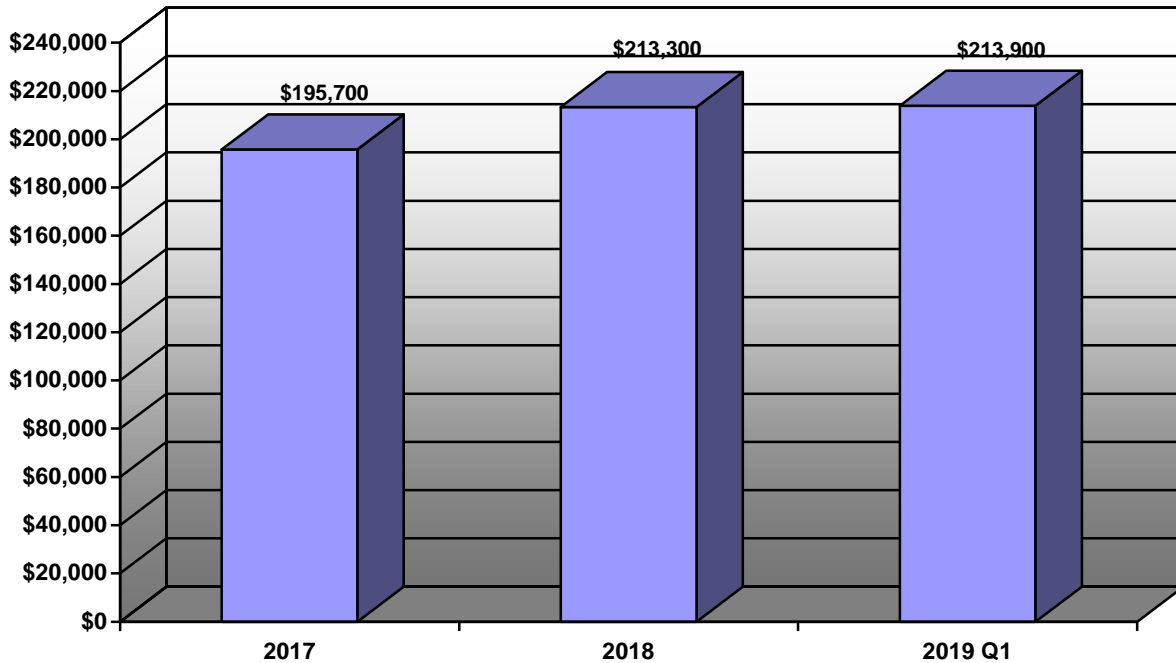

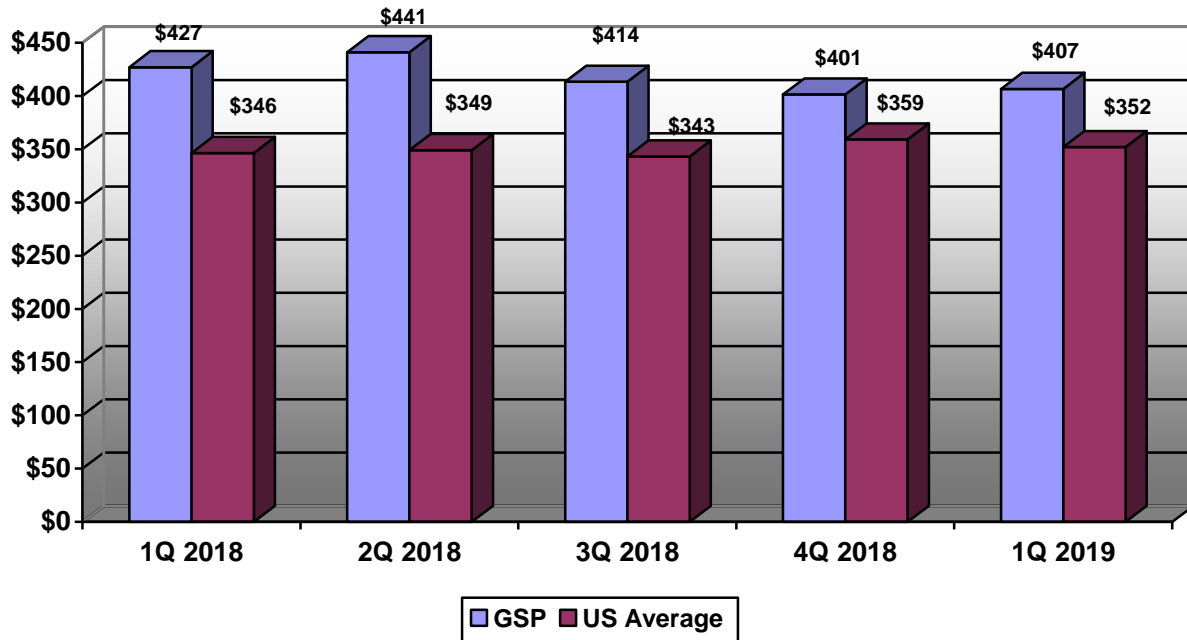
**Median Sales Price of Existing Single Family Homes

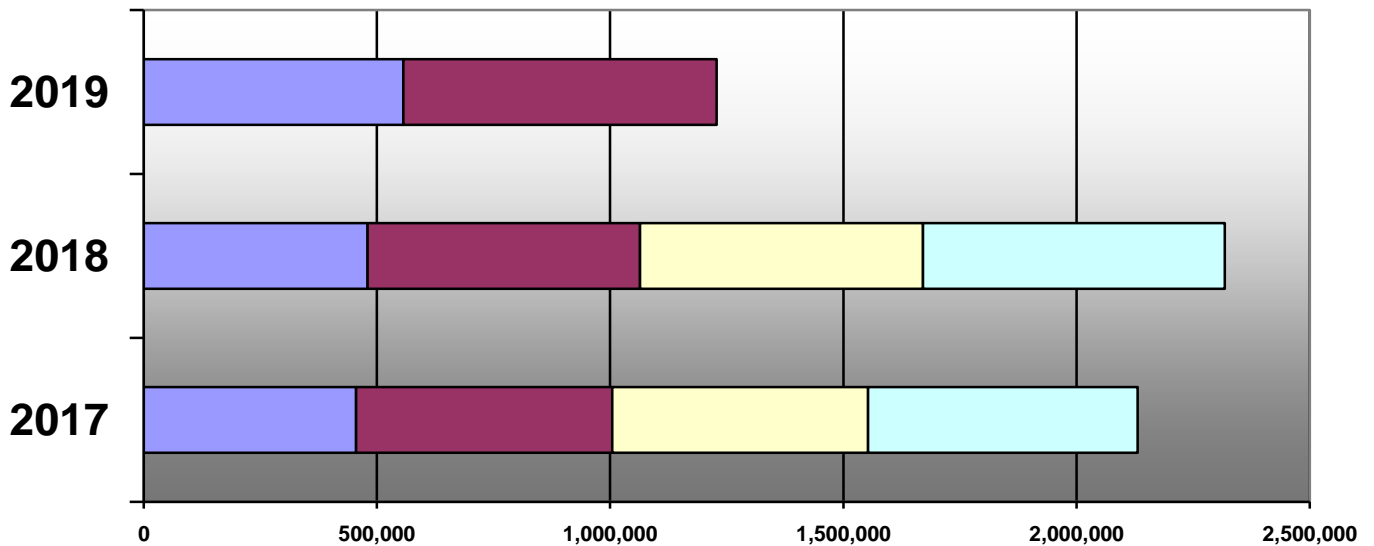
### Average Domestic Airfare (latest available)

### GSP Airport Passengers (Total) 2017 – 2019 (2Q)

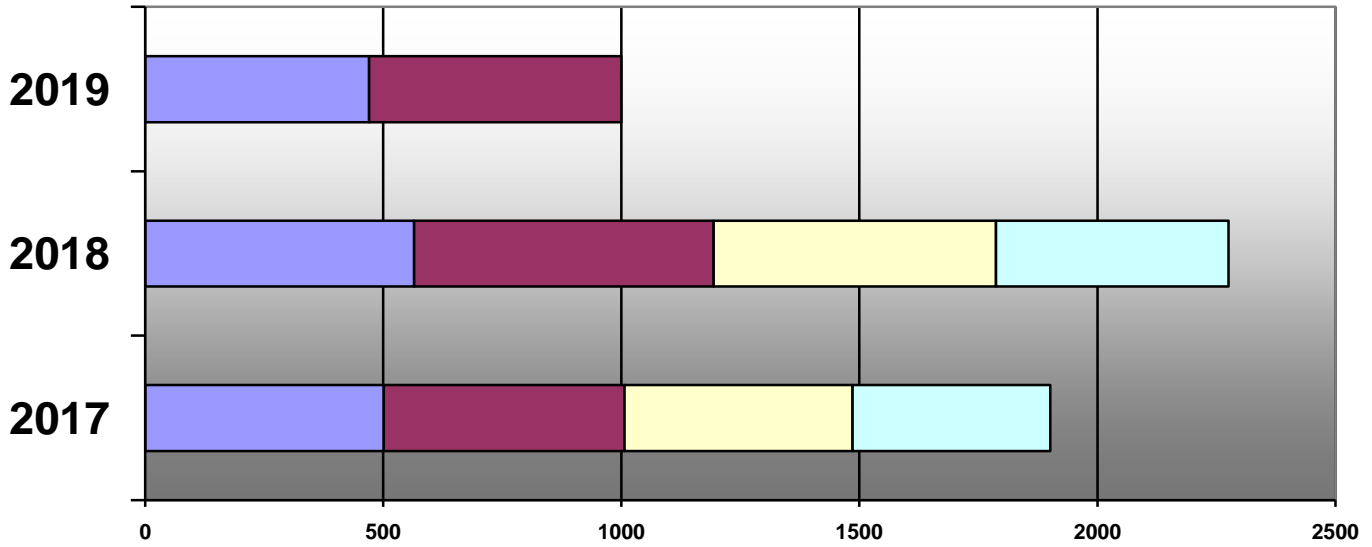

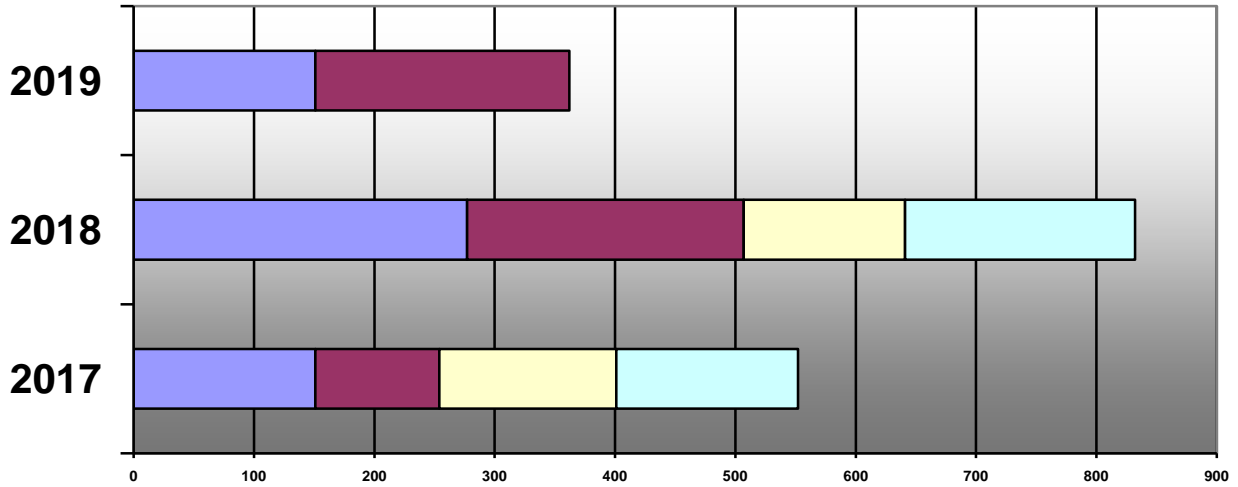

**New Construction Permits Issued – Greenville County (unincorporated area)**

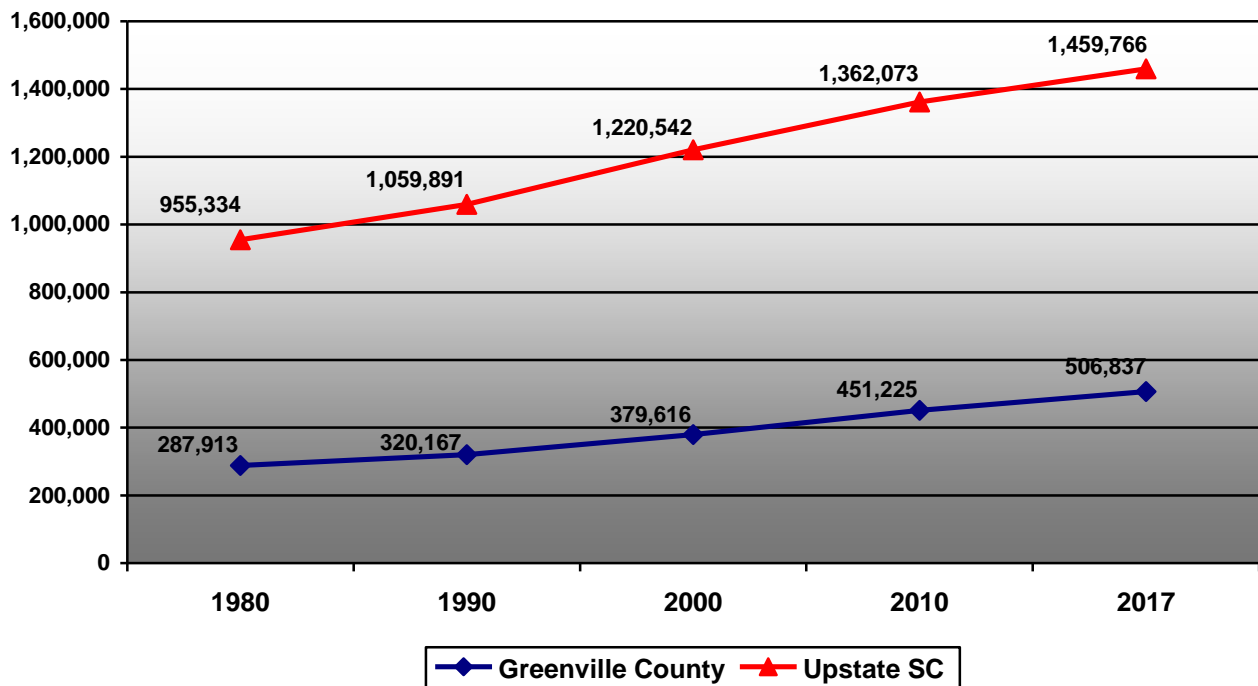
