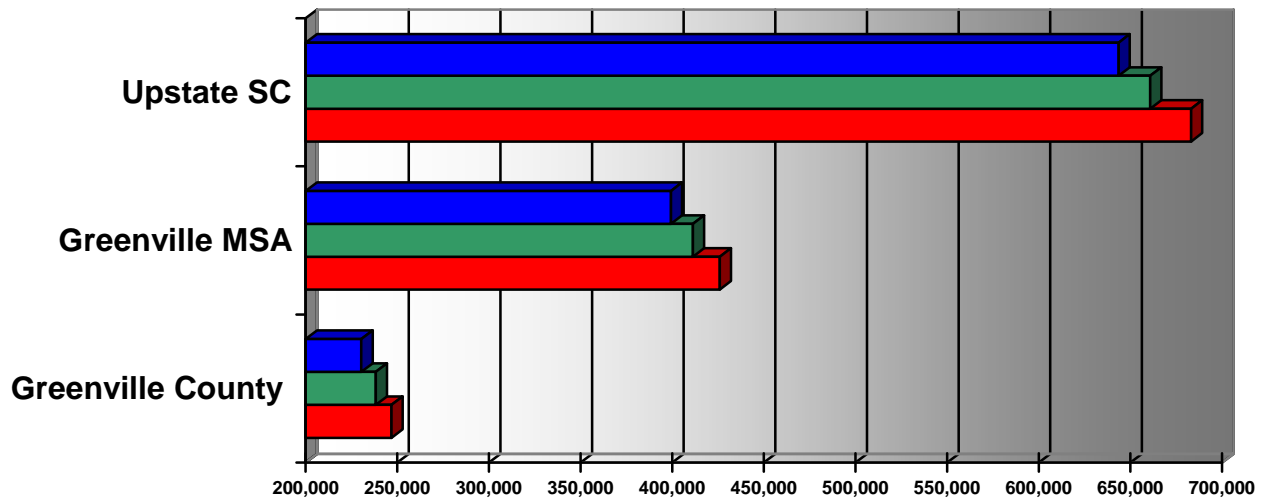

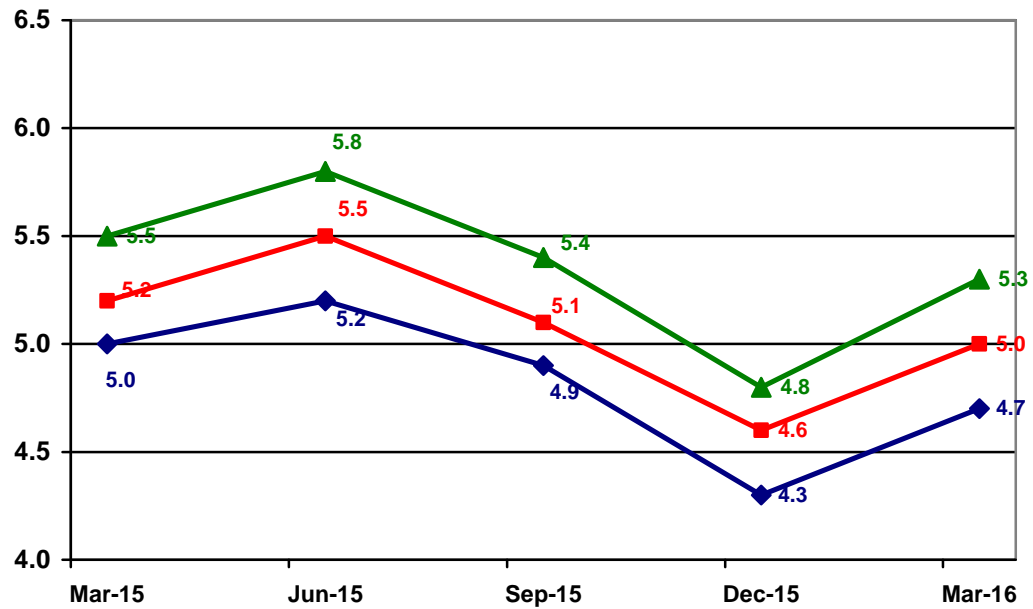

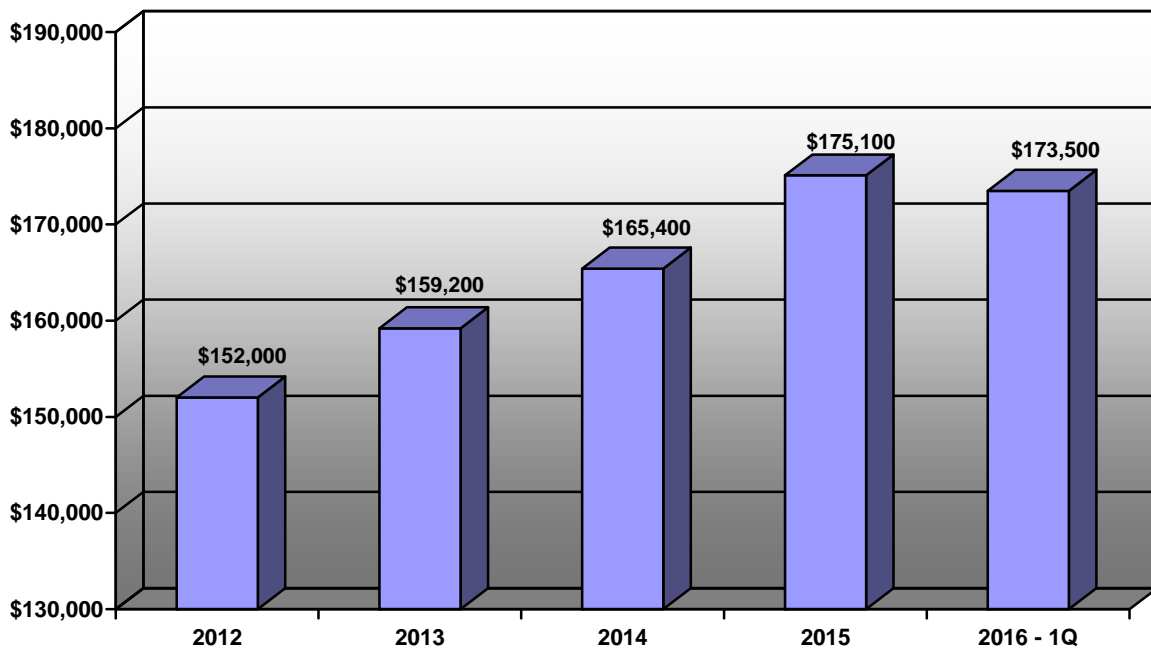

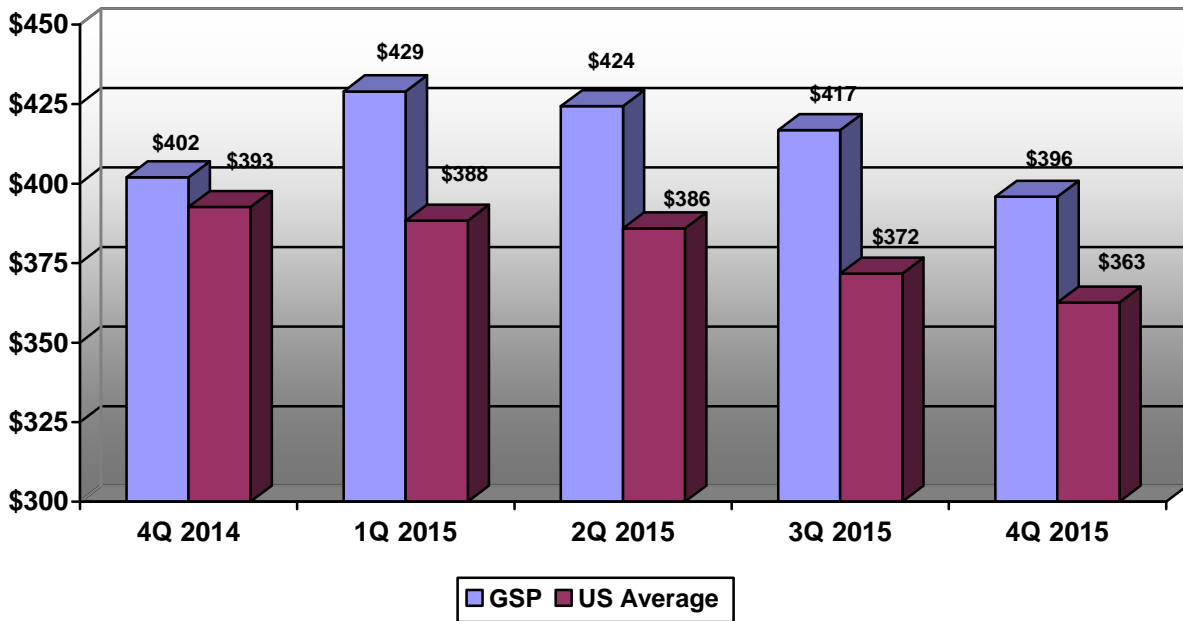

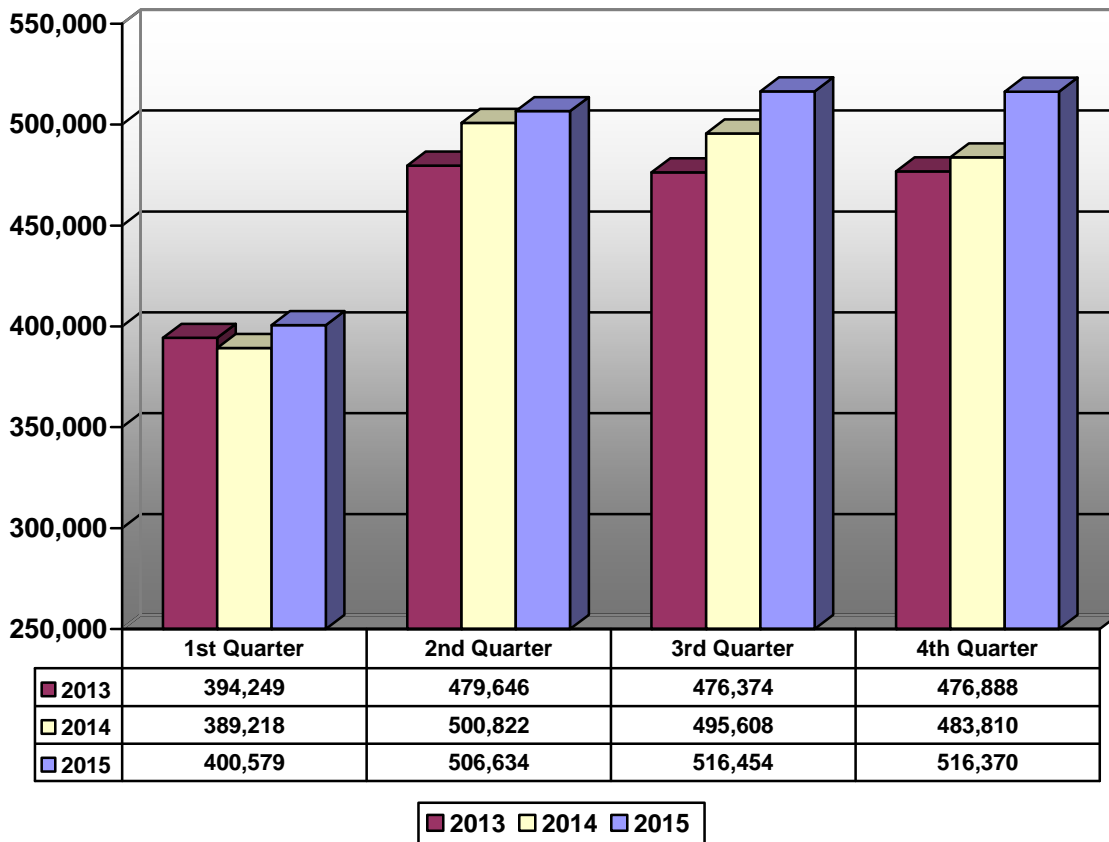

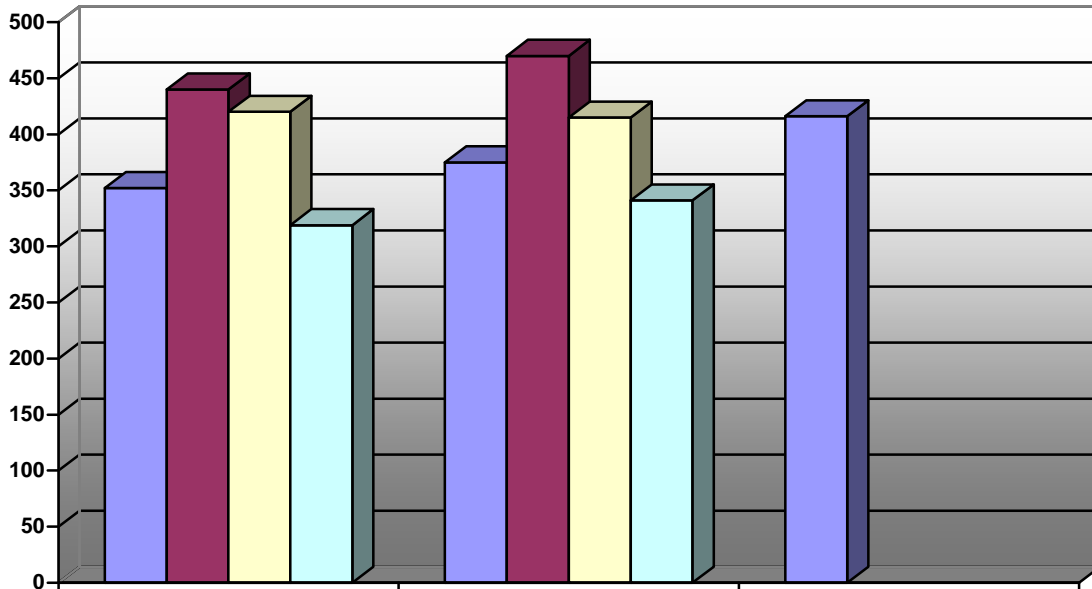
GSP Airport Passengers (Total)

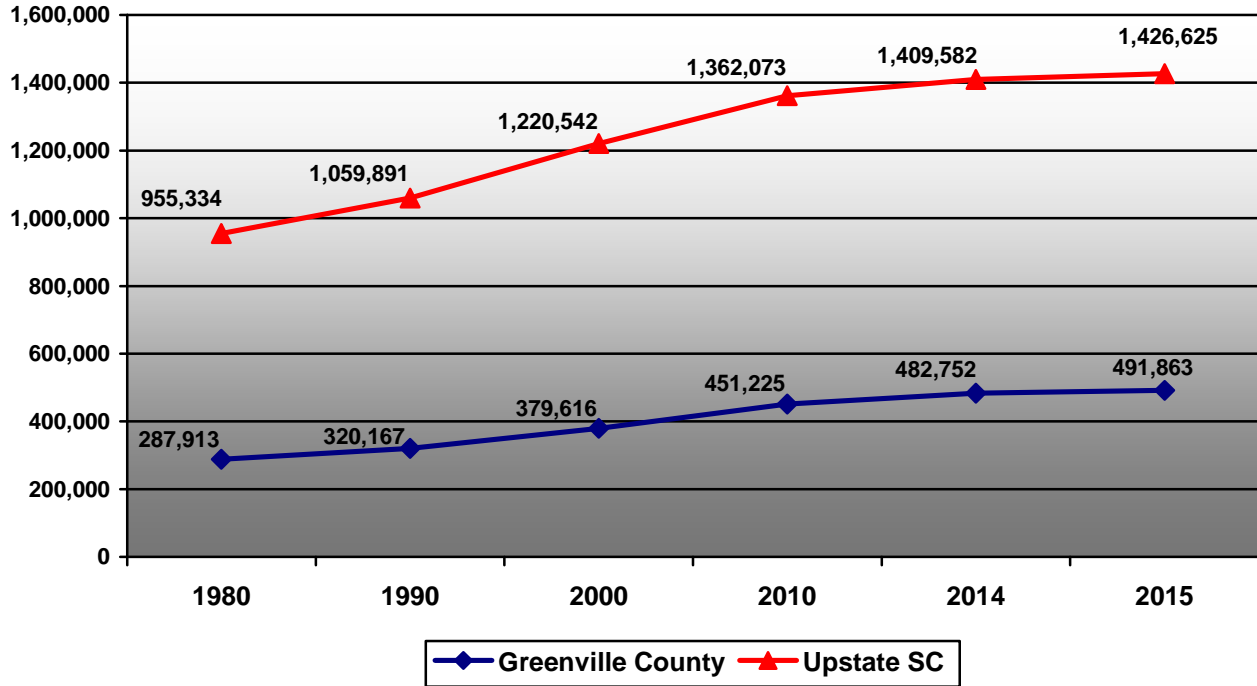
