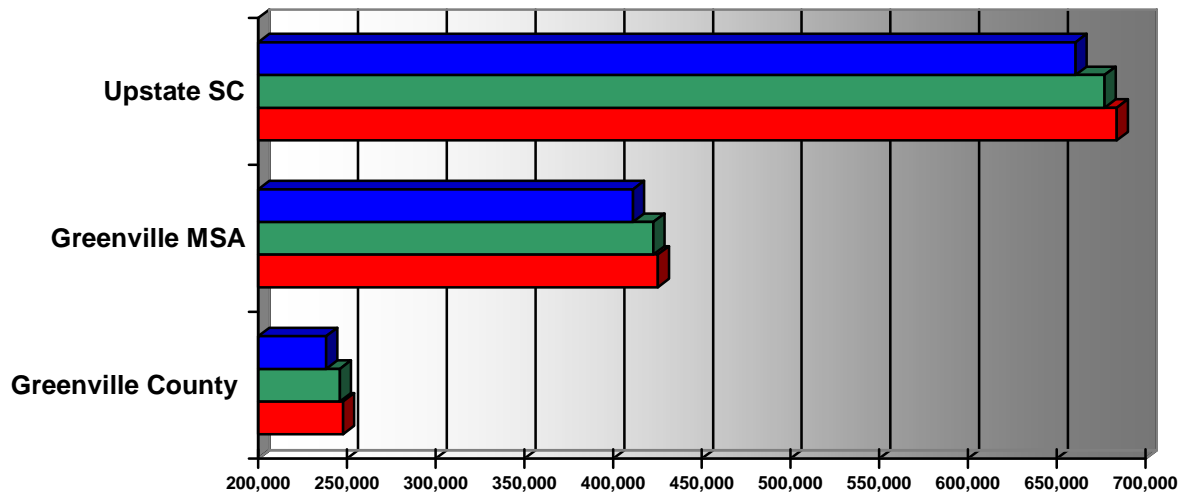

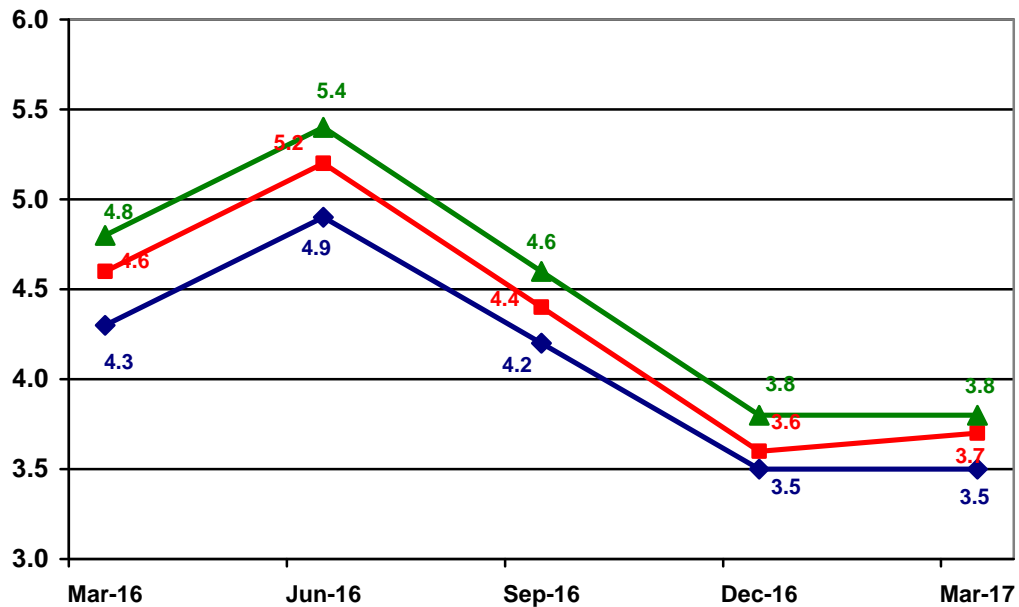

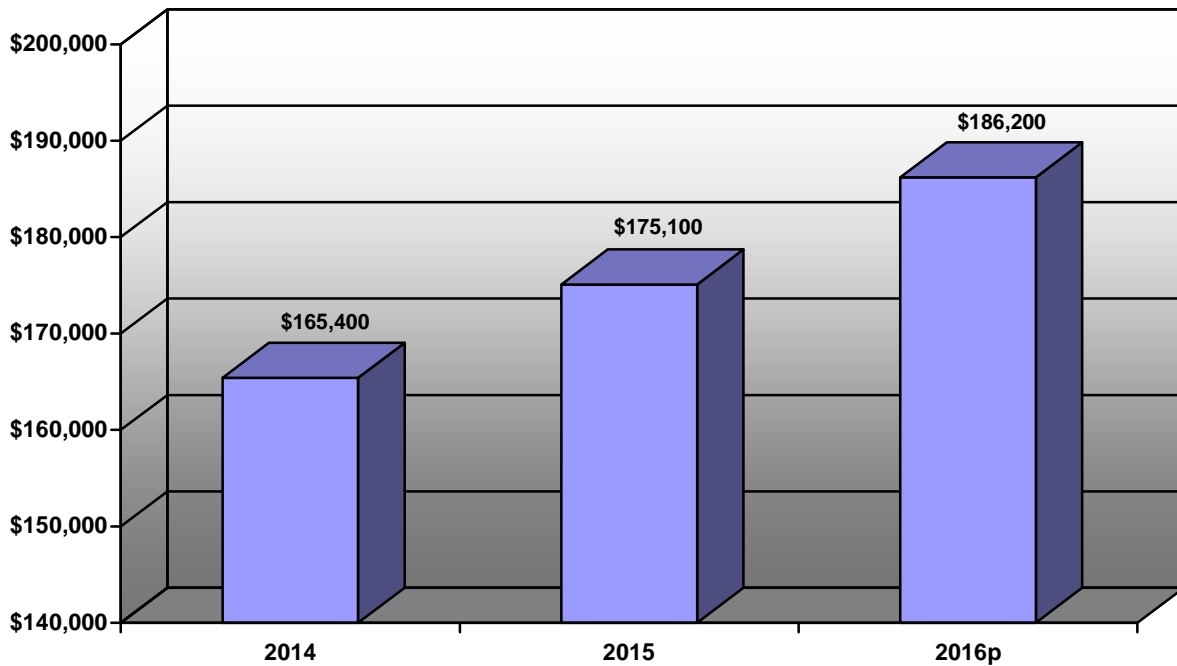

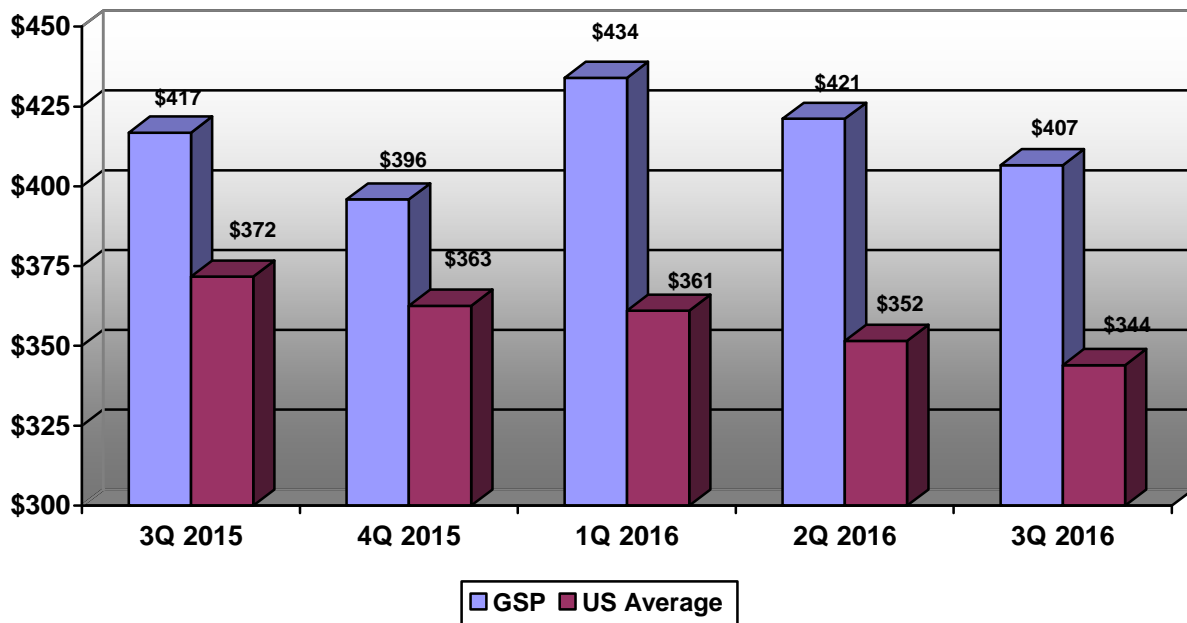
**Median Sales Price of Existing Single Family Homes

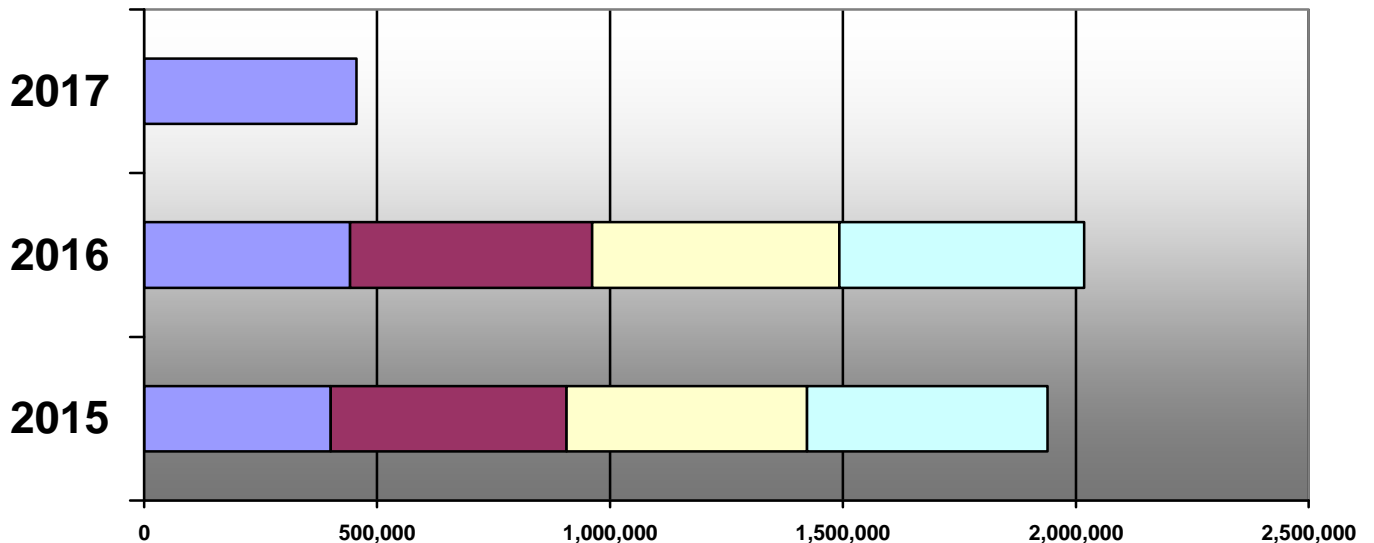

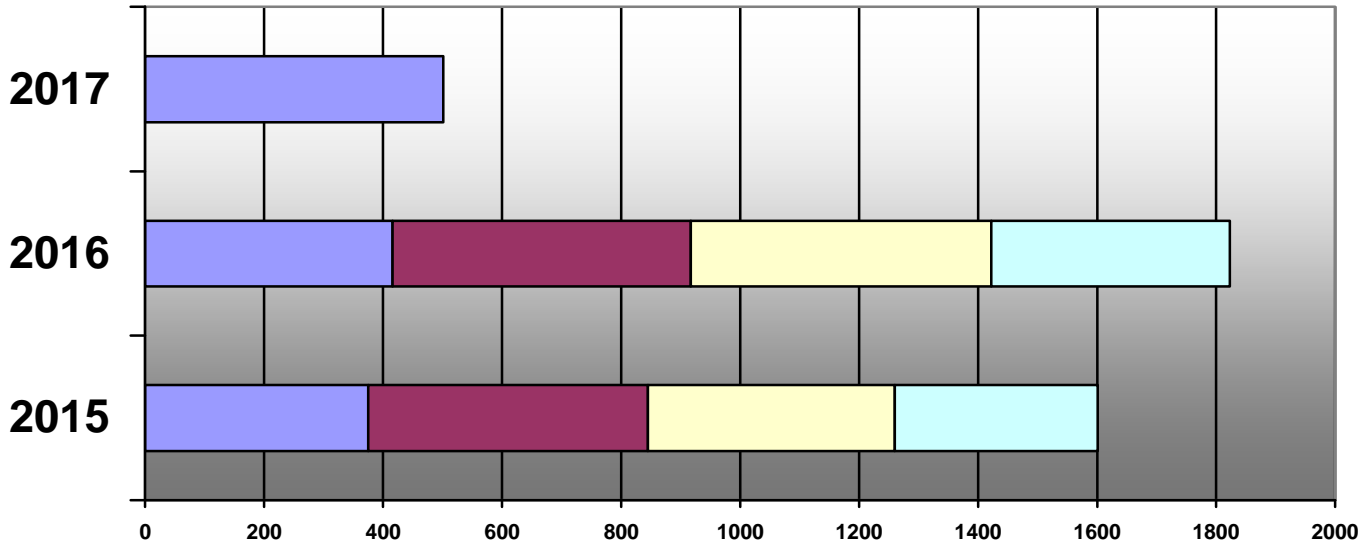

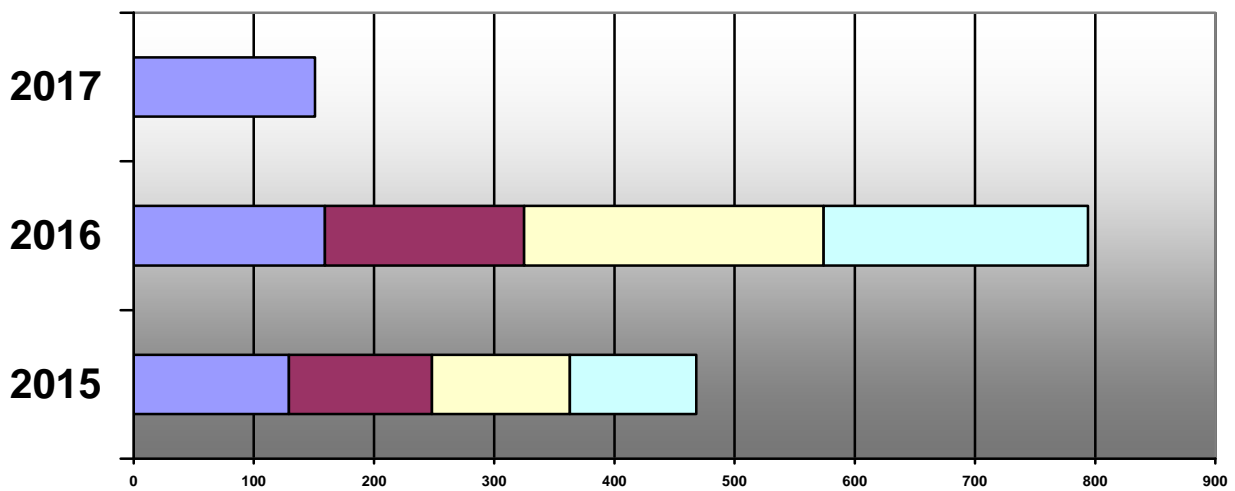

#### New Construction Permits Issued – Greenville County (unincorporated area)

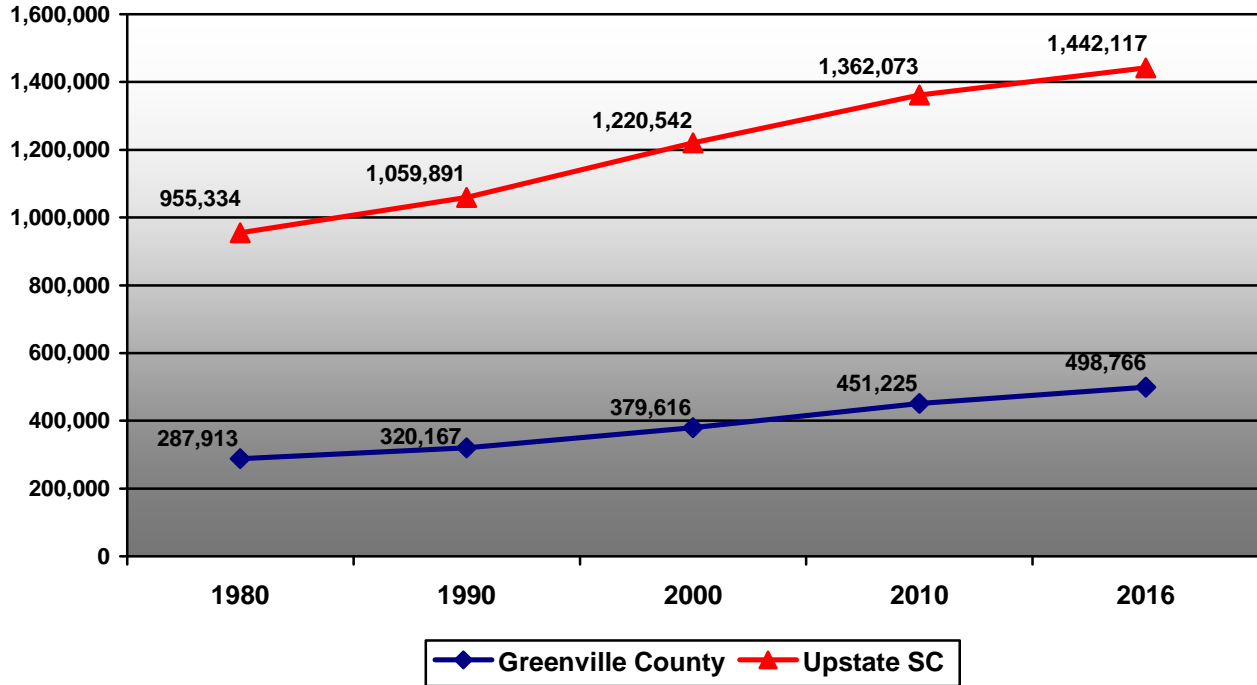
