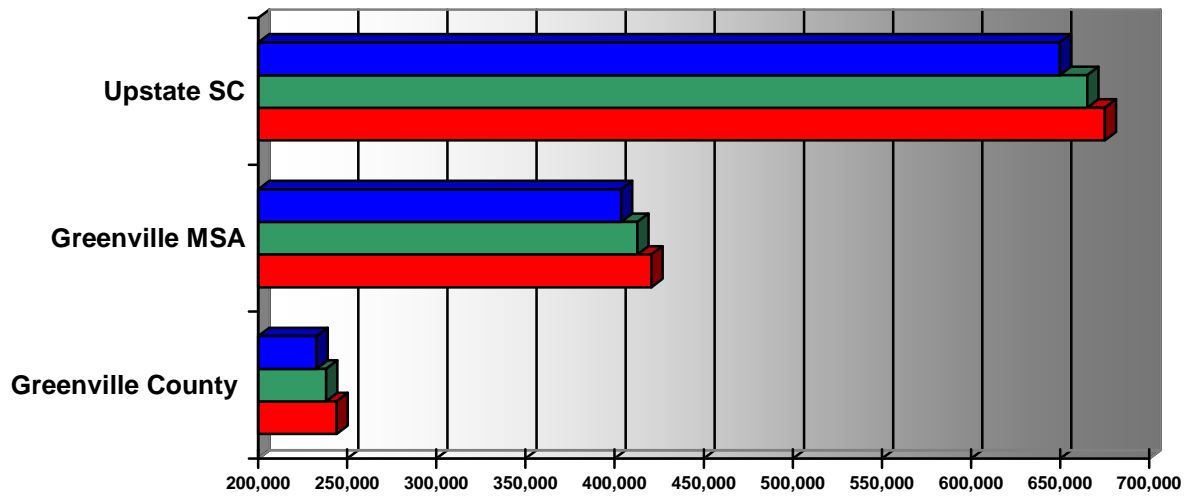

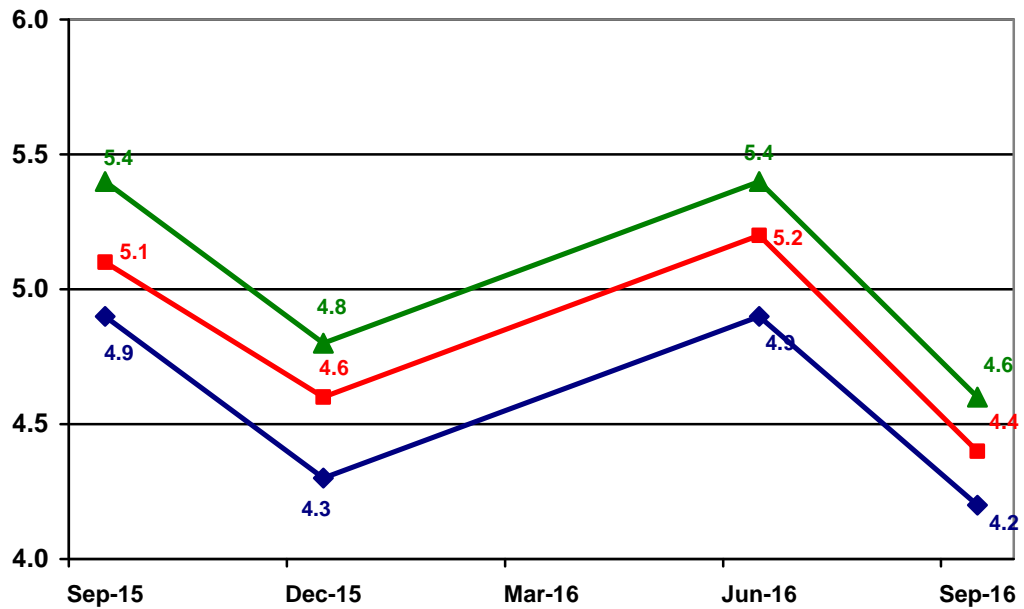

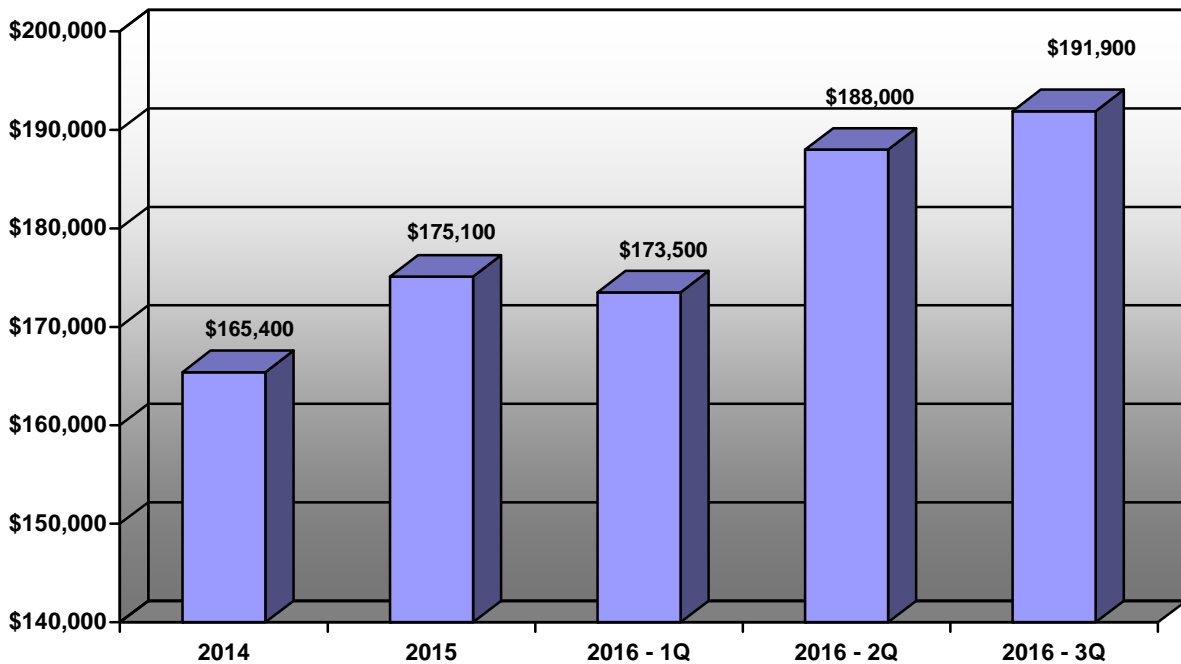

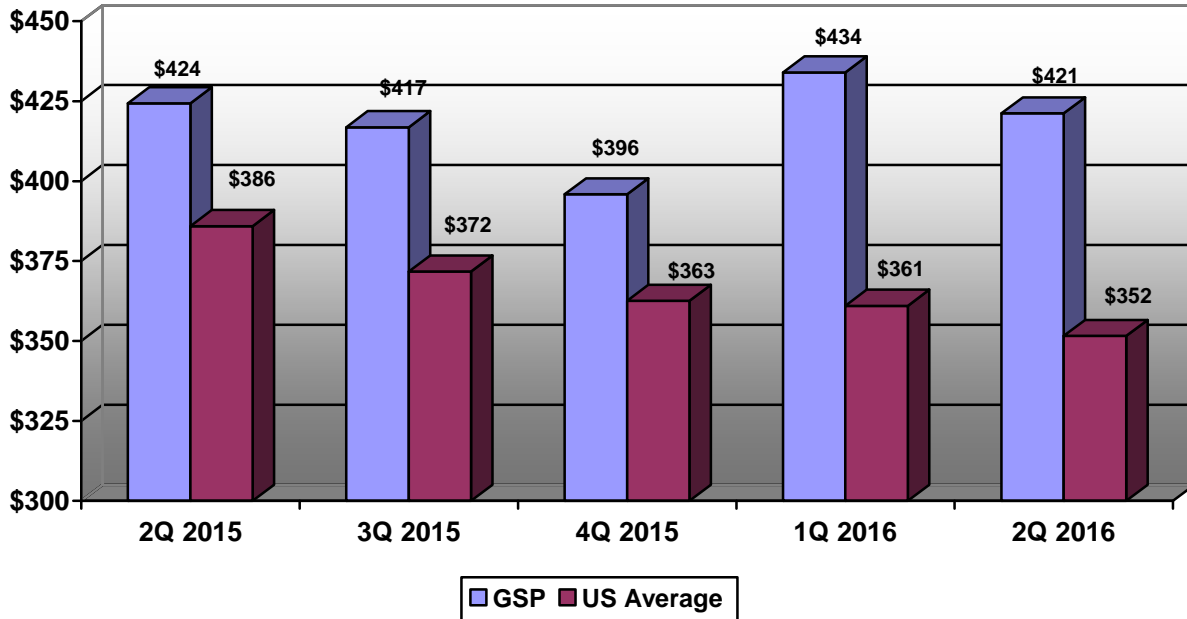

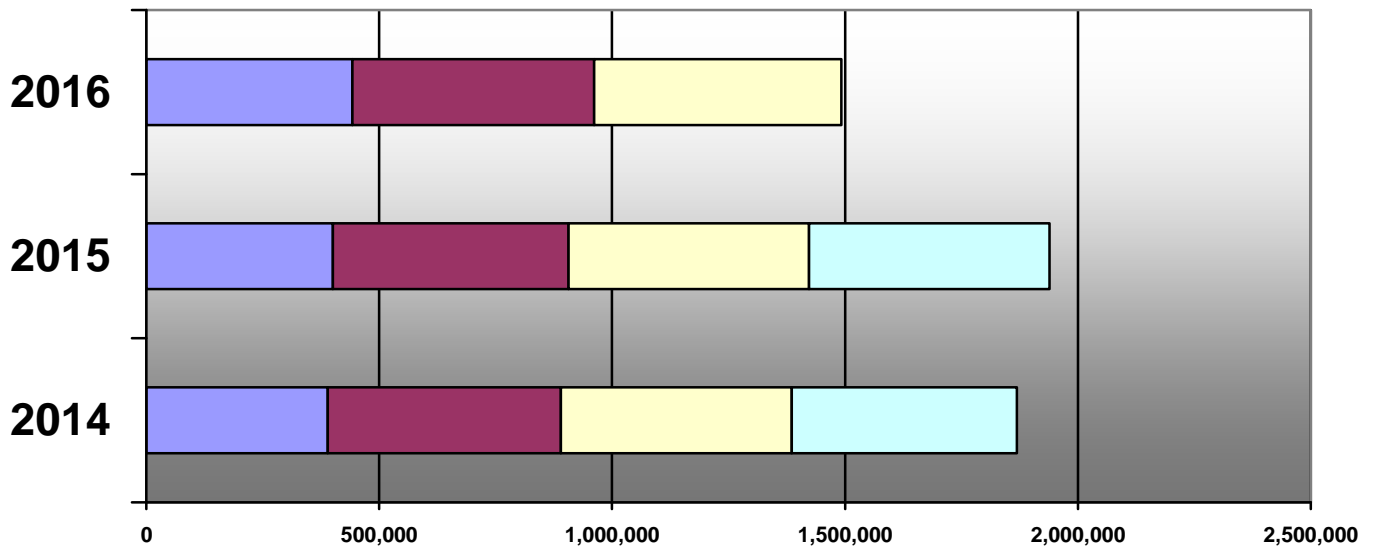
Average Domestic Airfare (latest available)

2014 – 3rd Quarter 2016**

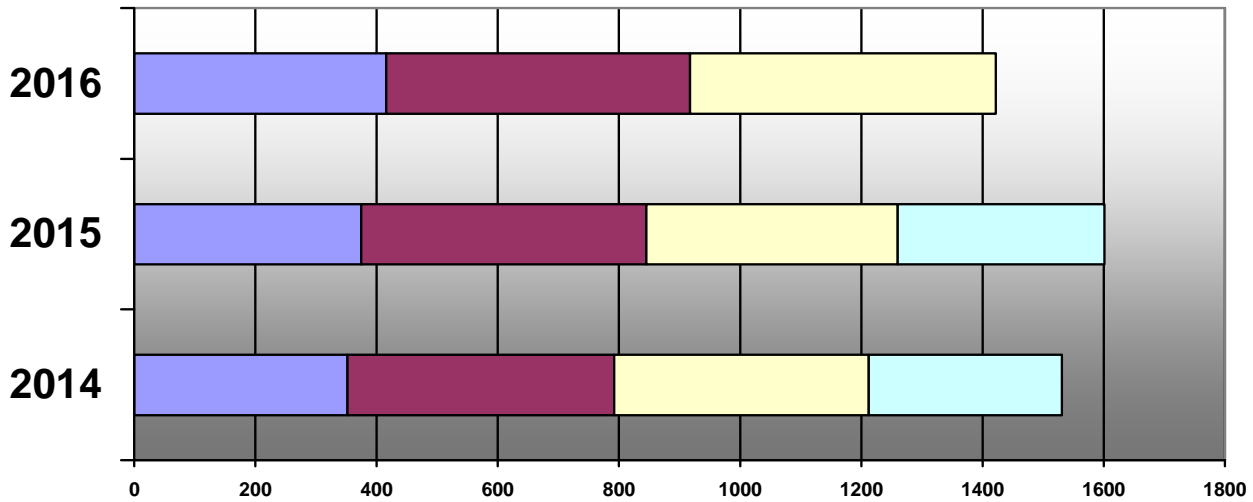

New Single Family Dwelling Starts – Greenville County (unincorporated area)

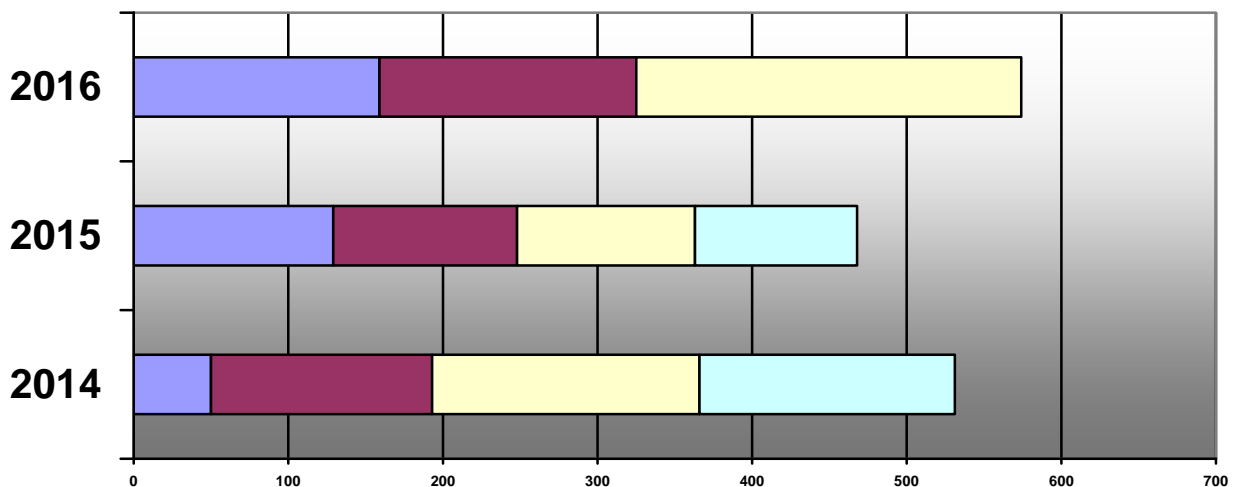

New Construction Permits Issued – Greenville County

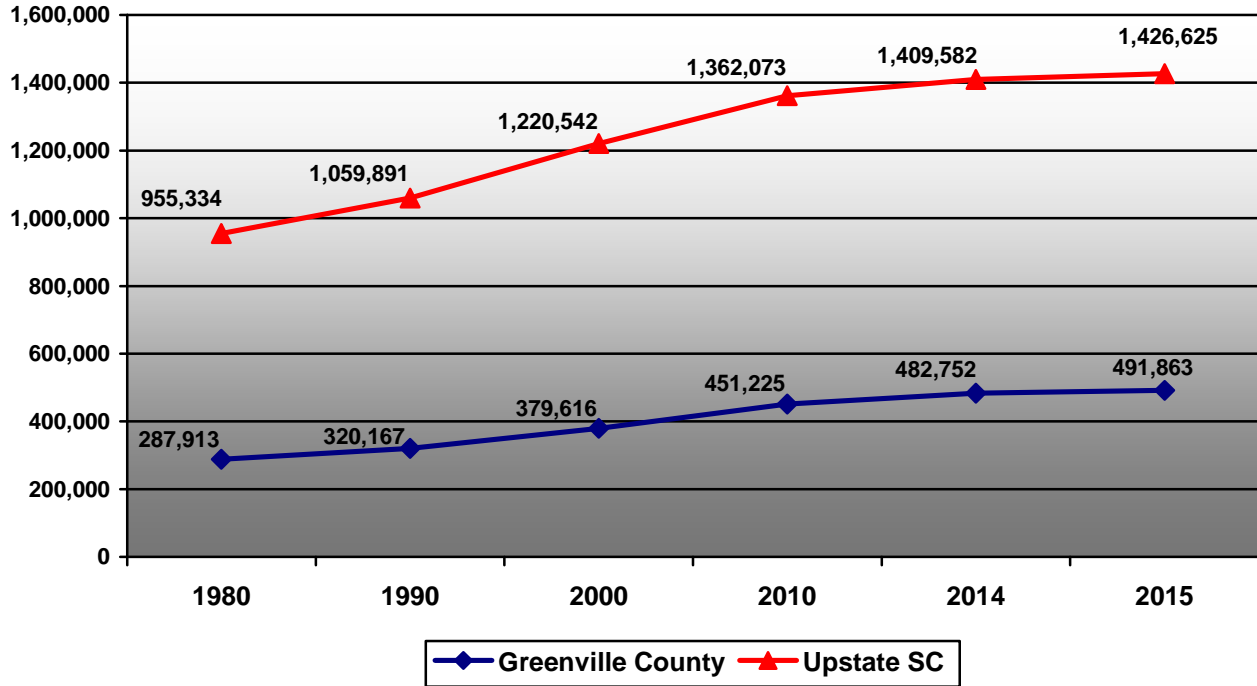
