GADC ANNOUNCES INDUSTRIAL PROJECT FOR GREENVILLE COUNTY

(Greenville County, SC) The **Greenville Area Development Corporation (GADC)** is pleased to announce that the **NTM Corporation** has selected Greenville County as the location for its expansion.
