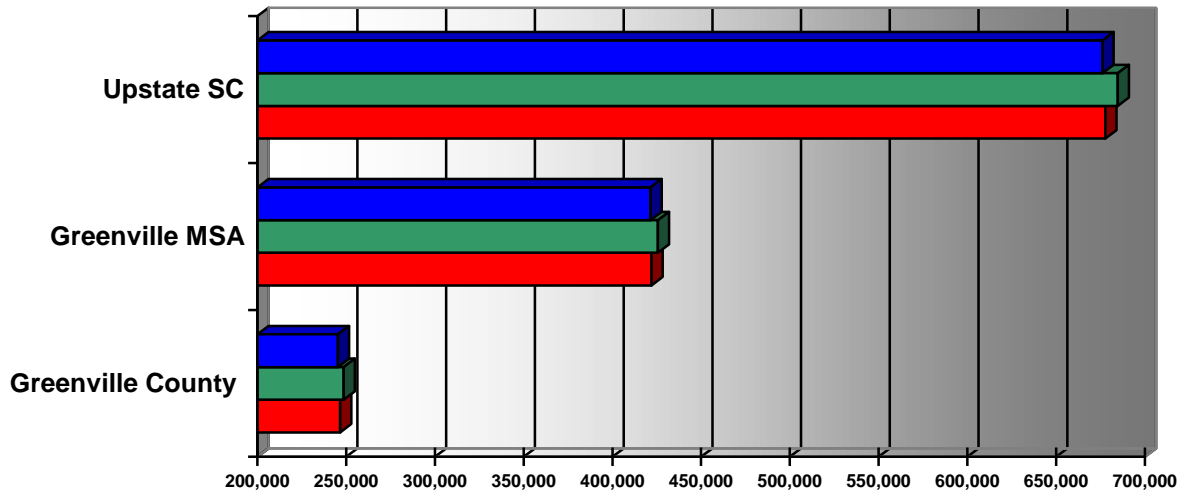

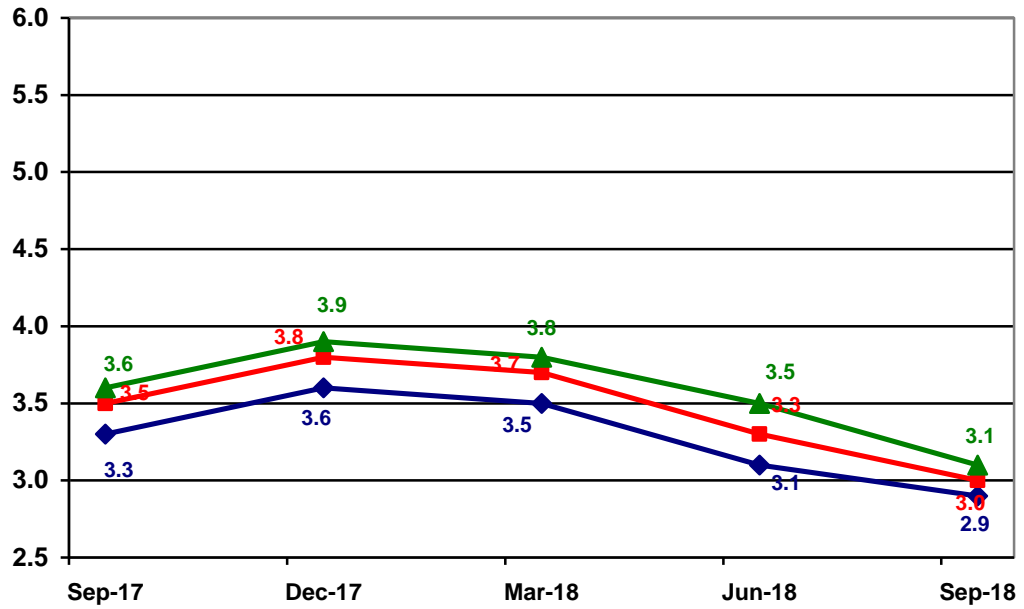

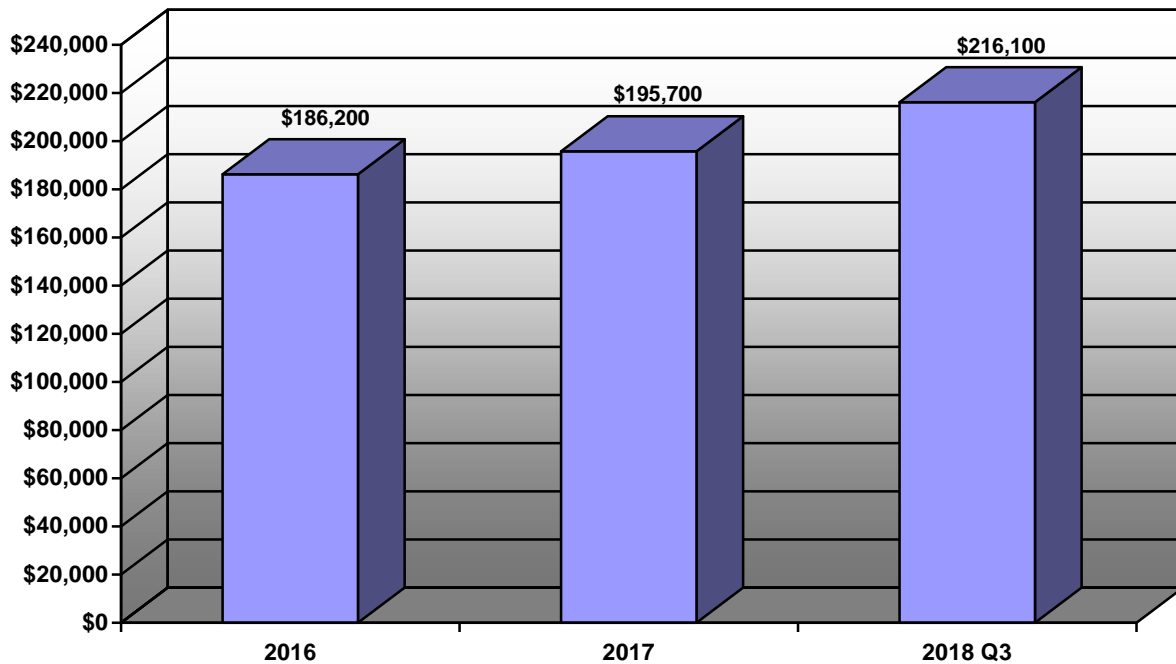

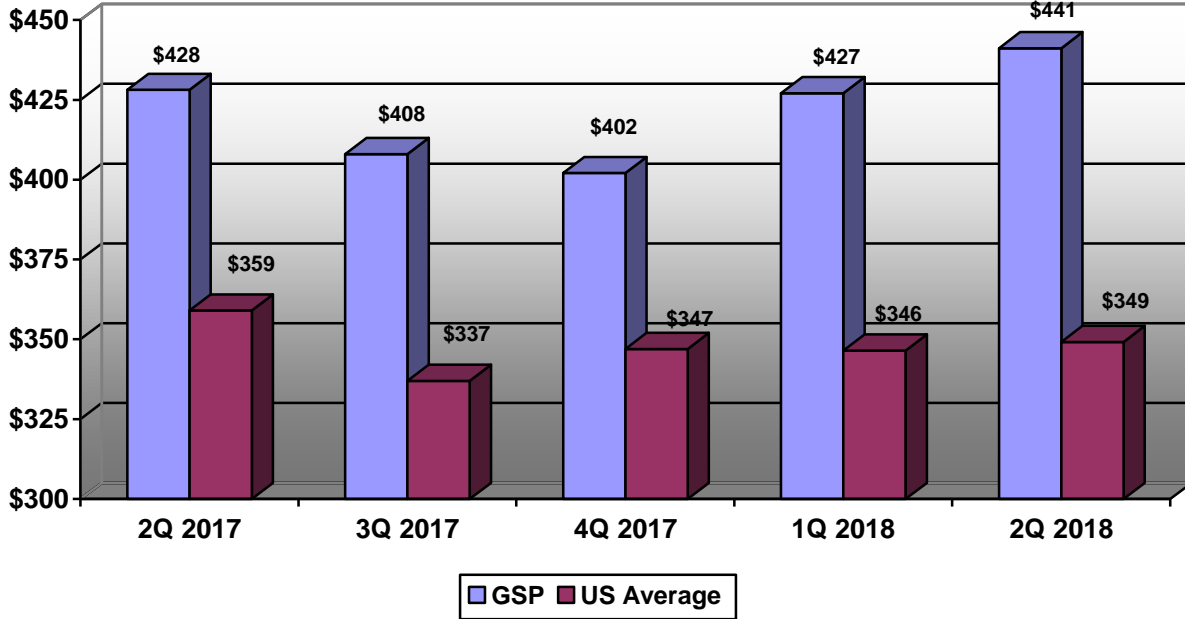
**Median Sales Price of Existing Single Family Homes

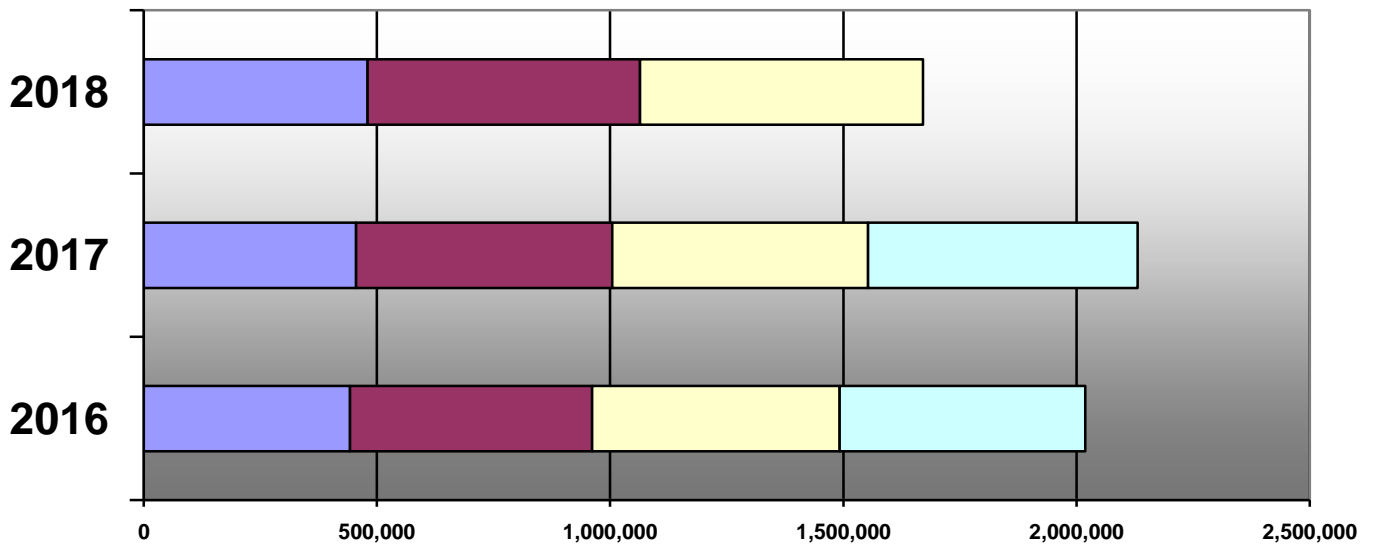
**Average Domestic Airfare (latest available)**

2016 – 2018 (2Q)**

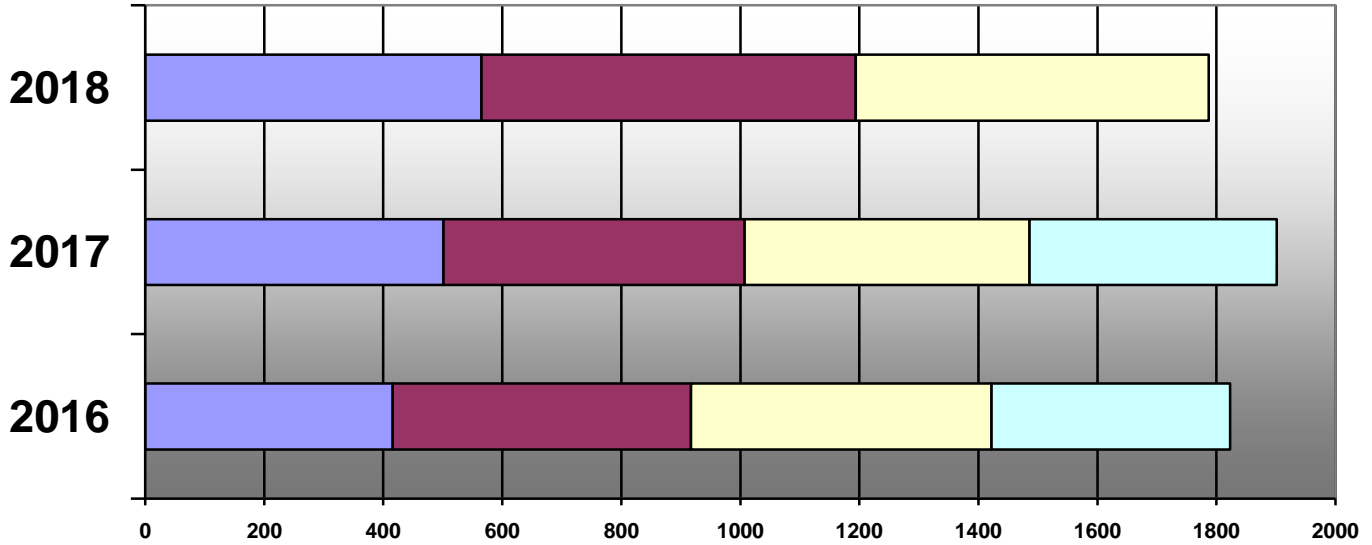

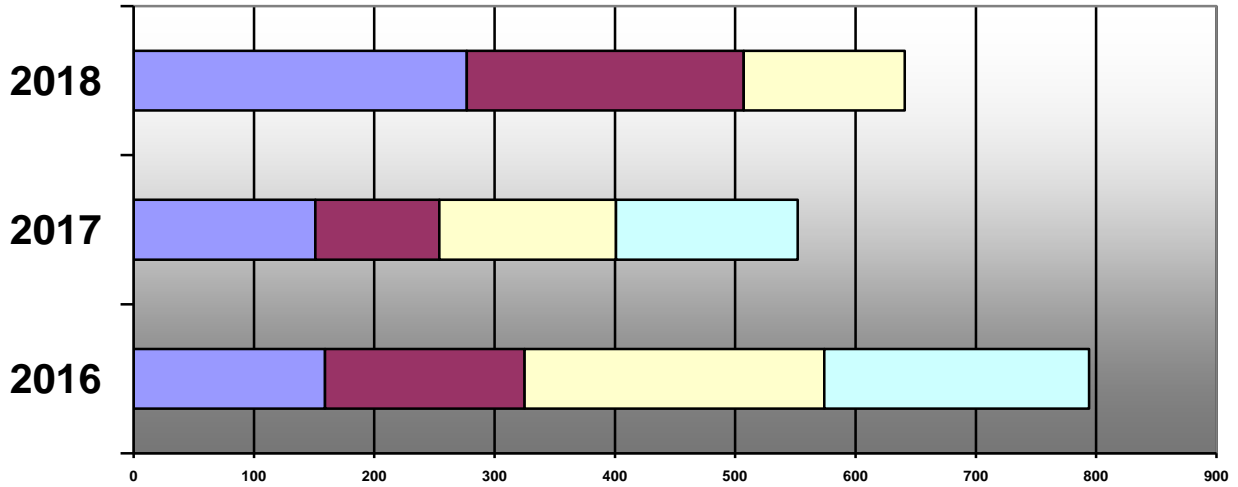

**New Construction Permits Issued – Greenville County (unincorporated area)**

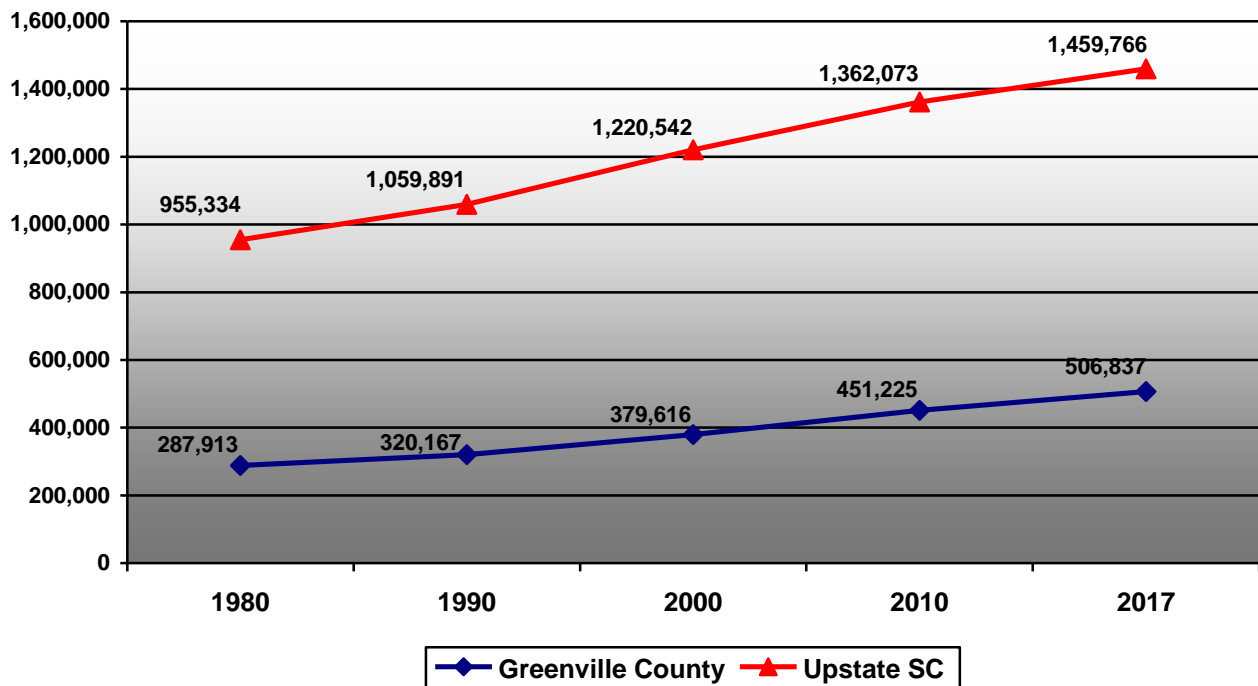
