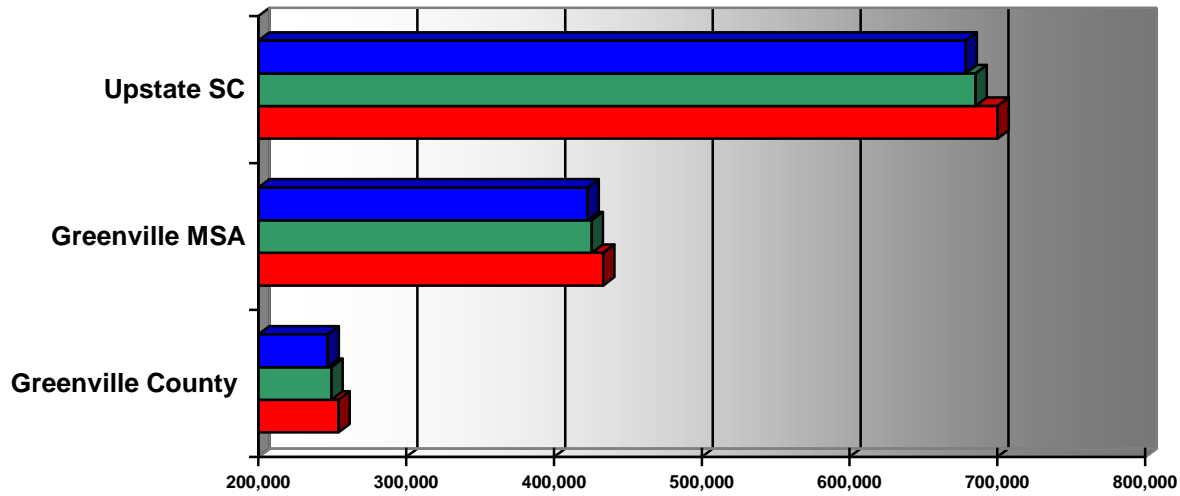

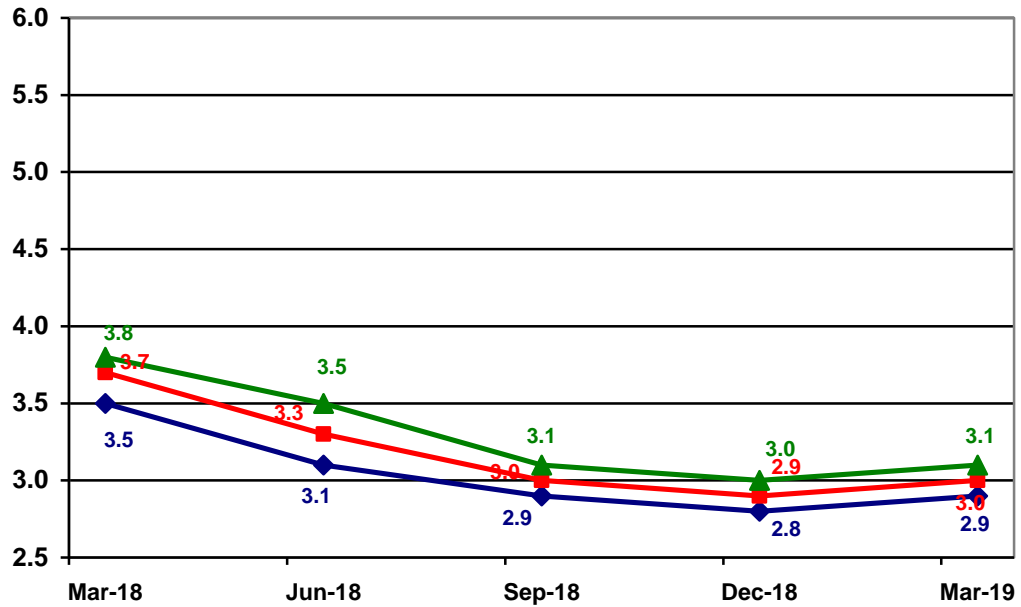

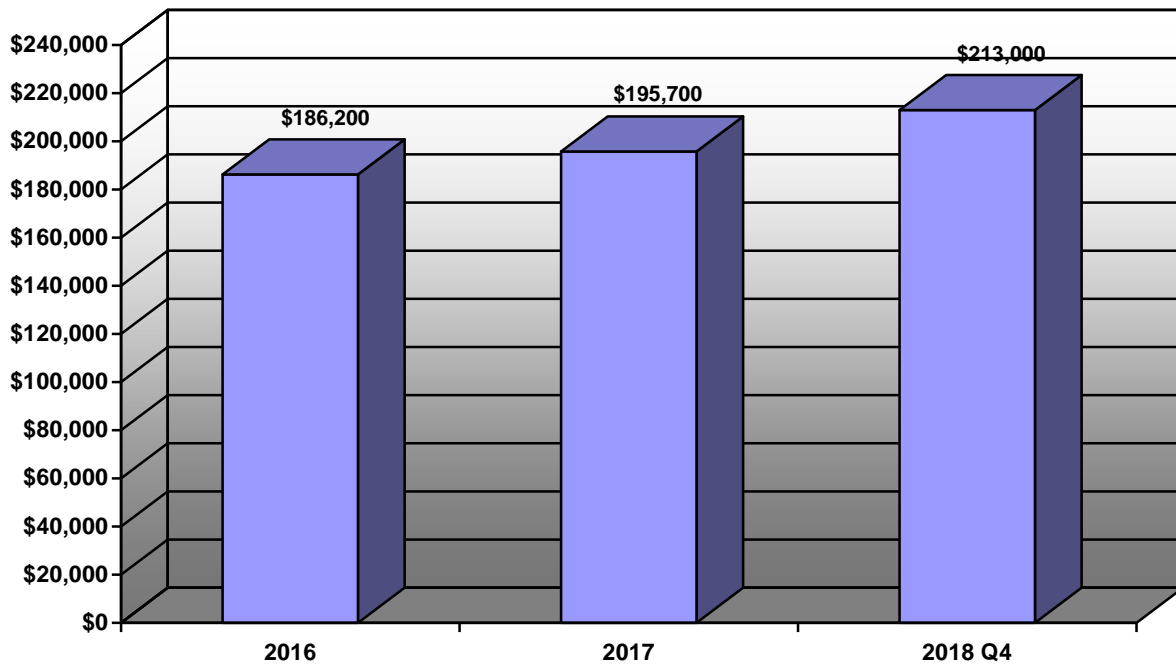

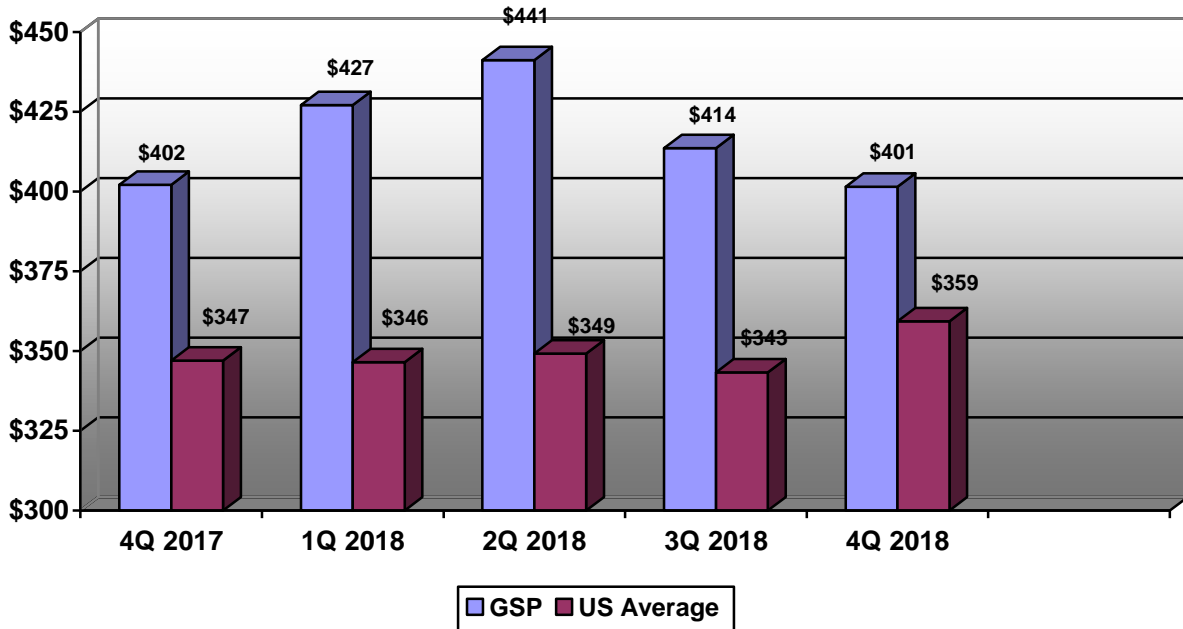
**Median Sales Price of Existing Single Family Homes

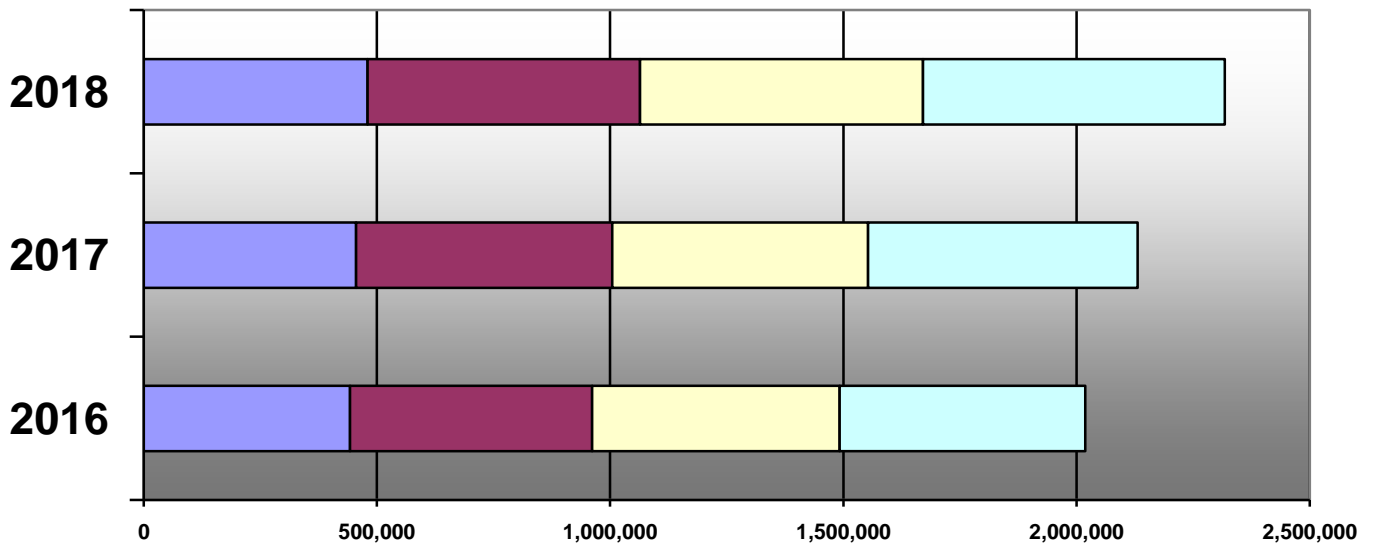
### Average Domestic Airfare (latest available)

### GSP Airport Passengers (Total) 2016 – 2018

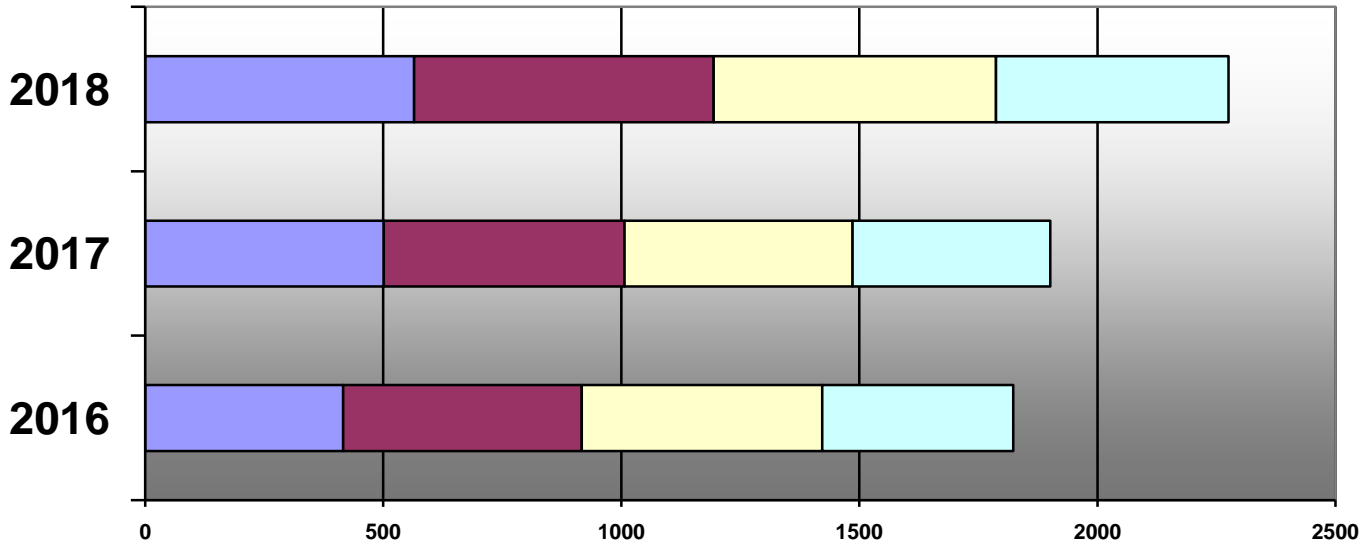

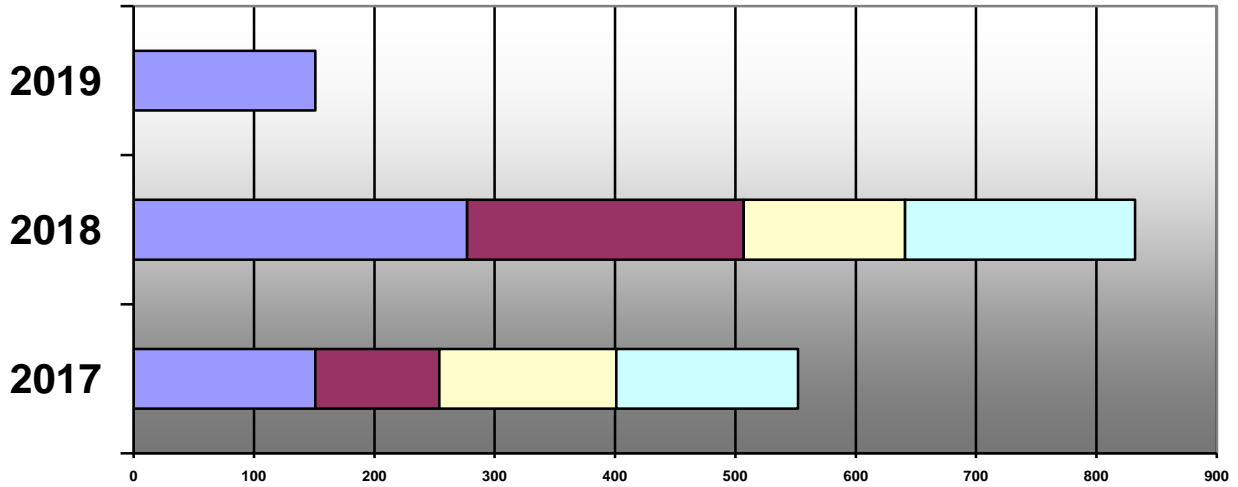

#### New Construction Permits Issued – Greenville County (unincorporated area)

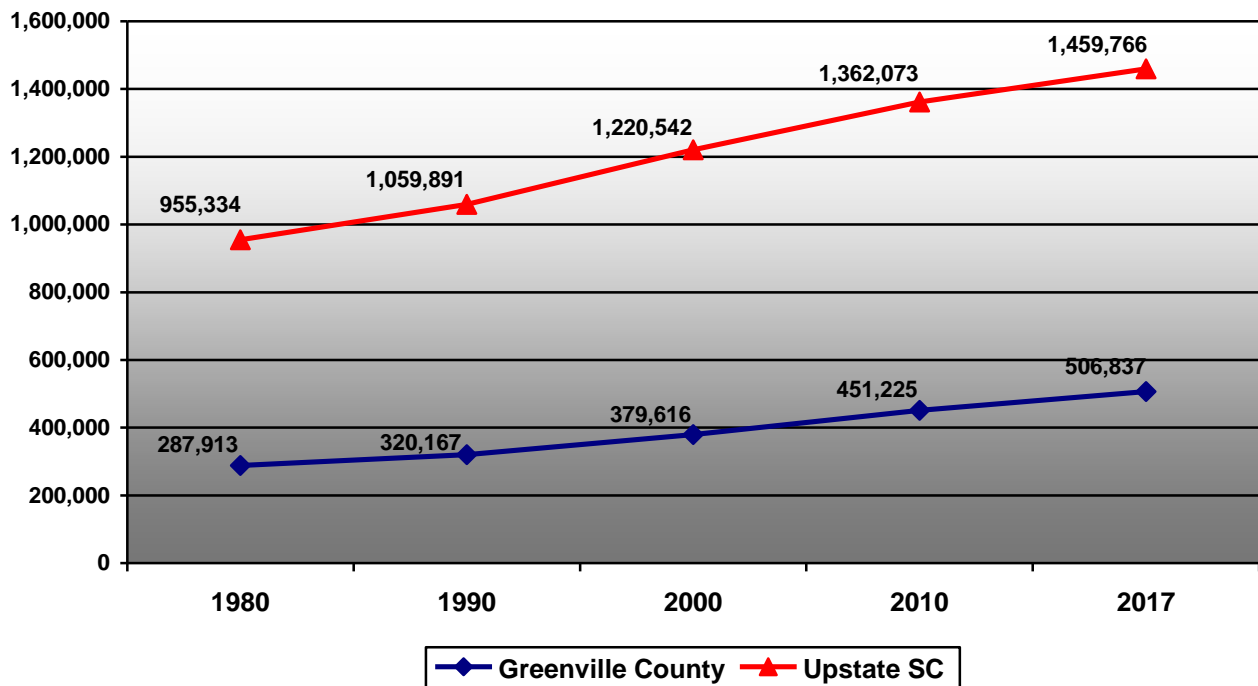
